Requirements for imports of ABP from UK

Listing public health and animal health

In Table 1 of Section 1 of Chapter I of Annex XIV to Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 for ABPs intended for the production of **feed for farmed animals**

In Table 2 of Section 1 of Chapter II of Annex XIV to Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 for ABPs intended for **technical purposes** and for the production of **petfood**

Listing based on:

- authorisation of the third country for imports of live animals or PAO, or
- individual authorisation in Table 1 or Table 2 for particular commodities

Listing approved residue control plan

Directive 96/23/EC on measures to monitor certain substances and residues in live animals and animal products;

- for ABPs intended for the **production of feed for farmed animals**

Listing establishments and plants

- Article 30 of Regulation (EU) No 142/2011
- List of approved or registered establishments or plants in third countries **in TRACES**

Compliance with import/transit requirements

- Article 41 of Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009
- Table 1 of Section 1 of Chapter I of Annex XIV of 142/2011 – Cat 3 for feed chain
- Table 2 of Section 1 of Chapter II of Annex XIV to 142/2011 - outside feed chain

Flexibility provisions applicable to:

- The imports of research and scientific samples (Article 17 of Reg. 1069/2009)

Business operators are responsible for imports of ABP

Mandatory controls in Border Inspection Posts

Commission Decision 2009/821/EC on a list of approved border inspection posts, on rules on the inspections carried out by Commission veterinary experts and laying down the veterinary units in Traces

Each consignment undergoes documentary and identity checks and at an appropriate frequency physical checks

Commission Decision 94/360/EC on the reduced frequency of physical checks of consignments of certain products to be imported from third countries

Each consignment has to be accompanied by a certificate or commercial document

Health certificate or commercial document:

- Models set out in Annex XV to Regulation (EU) No 142/2011
- Attestation of compliance with:
 - general requirements (Article 41 of Reg. 1069/2009)
 - specific requirements (Annex XIV to Reg. 142/2011)
