- Content: information on legislation, policies and initiatives related to food loss and waste prevention and reduction
- Objectives:
 - ❖ Keep stakeholders up-to-date with national initiatives
 - ❖ Living source of information for Member States, in order to facilitate transfer and uptake of actions

Information on target(s) set to reduce food loss and waste, if available

- ✓ national target(s)
- ✓ sectorial target(s)

MEASURE



- ✓ Information on activities to monitor food loss and waste (e.g. implementation of the EU common methodology, baseline, reporting activities etc.)
- ✓ Available food loss and waste data (national, sectorial etc.)

ACT



Actions carried out to tackle food loss and waste

Actions may include:

- ✓ National strategies & plans
- ✓ Legislative measures
- ✓ Voluntary agreements
- ✓ Consumer behaviour interventions
- ✓ Research & innovation
- ✓ Etc.

Member States pages – practicalities

- Access to the MS pages:
 - COM authorised staff
 - Appointed Member State representatives (EU Login)
- Content submission and validation process:
 - First version: to be drafted by COM, based on [MS contributions to Council, June 2020](#)
 - Content validated by MS & published on the website
 - MS representatives to keep the info up-to-date
 - Updates are reviewed by COM before being published
 - COM can also propose changes, for MS representatives' consideration
