Update frequency and public accessibility of information and data


- The MTA is updated twice a year (prior to the UDG meeting)

Action Plans and Actions


86% of the UA Partnerships have a finalised Action Plan (12 out of 14):

In total: 115 Actions

- 38 Actions from Amsterdam Partnerships (33%)
- 46 Actions from **Bratislava** Partnerships (40%)
- 31 Actions from Malta Partnerships (27%)
