Preparatory work on the Action

- Establishing cooperation with NGO (Missing Children Europe)
- Thematic working group with city-experts, NGO's and Commission
- Investing in fact-finding and enlarging city-cooperation: 14 case studies in cities in cooperation with the Secretariat





Developing recommendations

- Assessment of case-studies by Missing Children Europe + cooperation with University of Leiden (department of Child Law)
- Outreach-activity (feedback) on case-studies through 2 workshops with city-experts during Missing Children's annual conference
- Guidance from thematic working group





Drafting and adopting recommendations

- Agreement within Partnership to dedicate expert-days on the recommendations
- Cooperation with the Secretariat (dedicated expert to draft recommendations based on all preparatory work)
- Discussion plus adoption in Partnership on final report





On the content:

Key recommendations:

- Prioritise children in migration in relevant EU funding
- Collect more and better data at EU level on unaccompanied migrant children
- Identify alternative solutions (with cities) on the age bottleneck in guardianship
- Support the exchange of good practices across the EU
- Promote research on protection and integration of children in migration
- Ensure the Fundamental Rights Agency's advisory role for European cities on children in migration
