



Interregional contribution to the Urban Agenda for the EU

This paper aims to inform the coordinators and participants of the partnerships of the Urban Agenda for the EU how the four interregional cooperation programmes, **ESPON, Interact, Interreg Europe and URBACT¹**, can contribute to the objectives and work of the partnerships with concrete inputs and activities.

Funded by the European Regional Development Fund, the four programmes are active in the entire EU territory with the objective to **improve the quality of urban, regional, national and EU policies** by providing **evidence, knowledge, tools and networking activities** to regional and local bodies in different countries.

Over the years, the four programmes have gradually extended their cooperation and mutual support. Since 2012, workshops at the European Weeks for Regions and Cities and common papers are among concrete joint initiatives. In the framework of the Urban Agenda for the EU, the four programmes are in best position to support the partnerships with existing and new knowledge, expertise and networking opportunities.

Upon the specific demand by the partnerships and when relevant, the four programmes, working individually or jointly, can develop tailor-made reports, data and tools, thematic inputs for events, publications, organise policy labs, seminars etc. To this end:

URBACT shall (continue to) contribute to the partnerships as follows:

- Participate in the two coordination bodies of the UAEU (DG meeting on Urban Matters and Urban Development Group) and in the Partnerships.
- Propose to the DG meeting on Urban Affairs, after approval of the URBACT Monitoring Committee, urban authorities to be part of **the partnerships** (as foreseen in the Pact of Amsterdam).
- **Bring knowledge and expertise** to all partnerships, from cities involved in URBACT networks², experts and URBACT Secretariat.
- Connect its **capitalisation activities** (working groups, policy labs, seminars, publications) to topics of the Urban Agenda for the EU.
- Contribute with its **communication activities** to the upscale of the Partnership topics at European level, through the URBACT website,

National URBACT Points, and the URBACT City Festival planned 4-5 October 2017 in Tallinn.

- Disseminate Good Practices related to Partnerships topics in all Europe through its Transfer Networks to be launched at the beginning of 2018.

ESPON can contribute to the partnerships as follows:

- Support stakeholder proposals for **targeted analysis**. Urban partnerships can consider submitting a proposal for targeted analysis to support the elaboration, monitoring or implementation of an Action plan.
- Develop a **working paper and/ or a policy brief** synthesising the outcomes of previous or ongoing research on a certain subject and presenting relevant policy advice.
- Develop, when possible, **specific datasets** on certain urban subjects and integrate them in ESPON online tools.
- Support the implementation and evaluation phase of the Action Plans with **monitoring tools** that could emphasise the lessons learned, results achieved for existing partnerships and inspire new ones.
- Organise a dedicated workshop on an **ex-ante territorial impact assessment** (quick-scan) for a proposed policy intervention.
- Support the debate on the topic of the Urban Partnership by organising a dedicated **workshop** or during bi-annual **ESPON seminars**.
- Promote the Urban Agenda through ESPON's channels

INTERACT can contribute to the partnerships as follows:

- Providing **information and contact** related to the Interreg response to migration related challenges,
- Connect part of its **capitalisation activities** (networks, seminars, publications) to some topics of the Urban Agenda for the EU.
- Contribute through its **communication activities** to the upscale of the Partnership topics at European level, through the Interact website
- Providing information and training related to the use of **financial tools, new territorial development tools** (CLLD, JAP, ITI) that could be implemented at urban level,
- Spread information and providing access through the several **EU networks** that Interact implements and runs, as well as, its Monitoring Committee
- With **KEEP**: the database of projects and beneficiaries of European Union programmes dedicated to cross-border, transnational and interregional cooperation within the EU, and between Member States and neighbouring countries.

Interreg Europe can contribute to the partnerships as follows:

- Provide regular updates on the results achieved by the running Interreg Europe projects addressing issues relevant to the Urban Agenda (e.g. smart cities, innovative procurement; energy transition, sustainable transport, circular economy)
- Bring **knowledge and expertise** from cities and regions involved in these projects
- Contribute to the Urban Agenda debate through its Policy Learning Platforms activities (e.g. peer reviews, thematic events, publications)
- Contribute through its programme **communication activities** to promote topics related to the Urban Agenda
