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



- Citizen Engagement

 - Change of name to reflect purpose: AI for the good of EU citizens

- AI HLEG Chairs will compile, synthesize, and come with a first proposal based on approaches & inputs received.
- Next steps & proposed method of finalising this part, will be communicated at that stage, depending on approaches/inputs suggested.



- Working Methodology Available tools:

 - Circa BC
 - Mandatory
 - Not all the same features as Google Docs, but has some useful features.
 - Rapporteurs to ensure that latest version of documents on CircaBC
 - Communication via CircaBC rather than email

- Send sections to Nathalie on 21 October the latest Master version to be circulated thereafter for comments


2. Second Wave (by 16 November)

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
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
