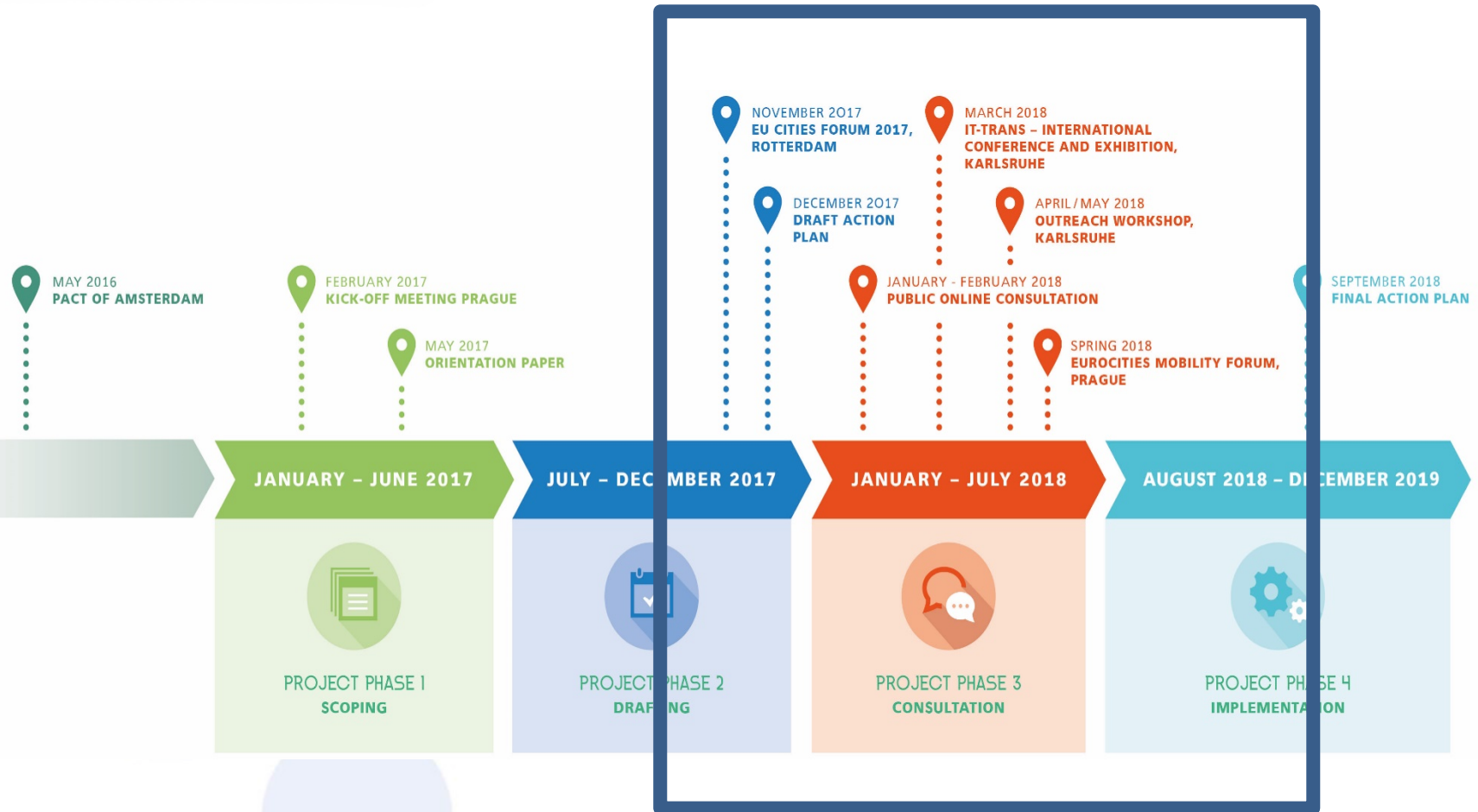

Objectives of PUM Consultation Phase (I)

➤ Improving the PUM Draft Action Plan



- stimulating the discussion on PUM draft actions
- including external expertise from different perspectives

➤ Raising Awareness for the Urban Agenda



- showing its potential for cities
- driving forward the process of giving cities a stronger voice at EU-level



Objectives of PUM Consultation Phase (II)

➤ Fostering the Multi-level Governance



- considering contributions and opinions from all different levels
- bringing together experts from all levels to work on the PUM draft Action Plan
- bringing together PUM political decision-makers to discuss strategic questions with view to the implementation of the PUM actions
