6. Description of content: First amendment to the Mandatory Standard SI 5115 part 3 dealing with diaper changing units for public use. This amendment changes the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Change the normative reference (Section 2);• Adds a new sub-section 4.6 dealing with phthalate content;• Adds a new sub-section 4.7 dealing with formaldehyde content in wooden products. All requirements appearing in this new draft amendment will be declared mandatory. Both the old standard and the new amended standard will apply from the date of entry into force of this amendment for a period of 3 months. During this time, products may be tested according to the old standard or the new amended standard.
