

# Biography – Dionne Kringos

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Dionne Kringos, BSc MSc PhD, is Assistant Professor at the Health Services Research Group and Programme Leader of the Primary Care System Performance Research Group at Department of Public Health of the Academic Medical Centre of the University of Amsterdam since 2012. Prior to that she worked for seven years at the Netherlands Institute for Health Services Research (NIVEL). In 2014/15 she was a Commonwealth Fund Harkness Fellow in Health Care Policy and Practice at Harvard University (USA). She is multidisciplinary trained (BSc/MSc's) in Health Sciences; Health Economics, Policy and Law; and in Health Services Research; and has a PhD in European Primary Care System Performance.

She has 12 years of experience in Health Services Research, Health Systems Performance Assessment, Quality of Care, and Primary Care System Evaluation research. She successfully supervised one PhD trajectory, currently supervises 3 PhD students, is a frequently asked reviewer for Health Services Research, Quality of Care, Public Health and Primary Care related journals and is a member of the Group of Editorial Advisers of the European Journal of General Practice. She also acts as guest editor of journals, such as the Journal Health Policy (2012).

She currently holds an advisory position for WHO Europe. She teaches at the Netherlands School of Public Health, University of Amsterdam, and at the Netherlands Institute for Health Sciences (NIHES) on Health Systems and Health Service Research Methods.
