

Biography – Liubove Murauskienė

Dr Liubovė Murauskienė is an Associate professor in Public Health Institute of Vilnius University Faculty of Medicine. Ms Murauskienė graduated from Lomonosov Moscow State University in economics and political economy, and completed her PhD in Institute of Economics of Russian Academy of Sciences. Later, Ms Murauskienė received international training in health economics and management.

She worked on the projects supported by the EC including those under FP VII, Health Programme, EuropeAid, ERASMUS, TACIS, PHARE and ACE; as well as the ones funded by the UNDP, the WHO, the European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies, the World Bank, the CIDA, etc.

Ms Murauskienė is experienced as a manager of SMEs acting in the fields of social research and outpatient healthcare. In recent years, she has focused on evaluative studies conducted in Lithuania as well as in Belarus, Bulgaria, Kazakhstan, Moldova, Tajikistan, and some other countries.

Her research interests mainly lie in the areas of health financing and structural health reforms. Ms Murauskienė is also an Associate Editor of BMC Health Services Research.
