Dear Sir or Madam,

You are kindly requested to inform us about cross-border <u>projects and other activities in the health sector</u> in your border region by completing this documentation sheet. This questionnaire has been sent to Euregios, Euroregions, Working Associations and similar cross-border structures. The analysis of the information sent by you and your colleagues will allow us to draw up an overview of existing cross-border activities in the health sector.

This overview is carried out by the Institute of Public Health NRW (Bielefeld, Germany) and funded by the European Commission. The project is being supported by a number of cooperation partners such as the Association of European Border Regions (AEBR) and the Standing Committee of the Hospitals of the European Union (HOPE).
