She is Economist, PhD in Medicine and Surgery, MPH, and MSc Health Policy and Management. She is currently Director of the Catalan Health System Observatory, at the Agency for Health Quality and Assessment of Catalonia. She has previously worked as Lecturer in Health Economics at King's College London & London School of Economics, as part time consultant for The World Bank, at the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and at the Barcelona local health administration. She is an active member of the Spanish Health Economics Association. Moreover, she has been recently appointed Vice-Chair of the Expert Panel on Effective Ways of Investing in Health, established by the European Commission. She has expertise in economic evaluation and applied econometrics, and has lead and coordinated research groups. Her main interests are around the areas of economic evaluation, assessment of public policies, health capital, and the contribution of health services to population health, areas in which she has published almost 100 peer-reviewed papers.
