DG GROW sent an email to the Applicant informing them to follow the SCCS recommendations and the last SCCS opinion on Hydroxyapatite and to prepare a full dossier in case new scientific data with respect to the specific Hydroxyapatite material(s) intended to be used in cosmetic ingredients will be available.

- Opinion on SAS – DG GROW sent mail to the Applicant (ASAPS) to clarify a question raised by the SCCS on information provided in the submitted dossier.

- Solubility of Synthetic Amorphous Silica (SAS)
