1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interests

2.1 New mandates

- Zinc pyrithione (P81) (CAS No 13463-41-7, EC No 236-671-3)

A rapporteur has been selected and will be appointed. The mandate will be adopted by written procedure of adoption after the meeting and will be published:

2.2 Draft Opinions (for discussion):

- Allergy Alert Test (AAT) as a proof-of-concept study to elicit a signal recognizable by laypersons. The revised draft of the preliminary Opinion was discussed and finalised. It will be adopted by written procedure of adoption after the meeting and will be published for a commenting period of minimum 4 weeks.

The Applicant will confirm if there is no confidentiality issue when publishing tables/graphs in the Opinion.

- Hair dye Tetrabromophenol Blue, 4,4'-(4,5,6,7-tetrabromo-1,1-dioxido-3H-2,1-benzoxathiol-3-yliden)bis-2,6-dibromophenol (CAS 4430-25-5)- Colipa No. C183 – Submission IV. A request to Applicant was sent following the plenary meeting. The dossier is on hold until end of May 2019.
- Hair dye Hydroxypropyl p-phenylenediamine and its dihydrochloride salt (A165). Submission I - A request to Applicant was sent prior to the plenary meeting and the Applicant provided the clarifications. It will be discussed at the next WG meeting (23/05).
- Hair dye Methylimidazoliumpropyl p-phenylenediamine HCl (A166) (CAS 220158-86-1). Submission I - A request to Applicant was sent prior to the plenary meeting. The dossier is on hold until May 2019.
- Hair dye Indigofera tinctoria (C170) (CAS 84775-63-3). Submission III - A request to Applicant was sent prior to the plenary meeting. The dossier is on hold until end of April 2019.
- Aluminium – A request to Applicant was sent prior to the plenary meeting. The dossier is on hold until 10 May 2019.

2.3 Comments on Opinions

- Fragrance Butylphenyl methylpropional (p-BMHCA) - SCCS/1591/17 - Submission II: A request to Applicant was sent following the plenary meeting. The Applicant replied the day of the meeting. The SCCS Opinion was further discussed and finalised. The final version will go through written procedure for adoption before publication.
- Hair dye 1,2,4-trihydroxybenzene (1,2,4-THB) (A33) (CAS 533-73-3). SCCS/1598/18 - Submission VI – the Applicant replied to the SCCS request but still miss some information. The dossier is on hold until May 2019.

- SCCS Secretariat is planning to participate in the Cosmetics Europe annual event CEAC 2019 on 12-13 June to present the SCCS state of play.
- SCCS members, *Janine Ezendam and Vera Rogiers*, are planning to participate in the Cosmetics Europe skin sensitisation workshop on 26-27 June to present the SCCS view.
