

## **SPECIFIC PRIVACY STATEMENT**

### **OBJECTIVE**

The objective of this consultation is to receive the views of stakeholders and potentially to publish the received contributions on the Internet, under the responsibility of the Head of Unit B5 – Medicines: policy, authorisation and monitoring, Directorate-General for Health and Food Safety, European Commission.

As this online service collects and further processes personal data, it is subject to data protection rules as established by Regulation (EC) 45/2001<sup>1</sup>.

#### **1. WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND THROUGH WHICH TECHNICAL MEANS?**

##### **1.1. Identification Data**

Personal data collected and further processed are only those data which are necessary for the management of contributions (name, surname, , and e-mail addresses), as well as the views of contributors on the topics concerned.

Internal participants may, in some cases, be selected through an appropriate sampling in Sysper2 or ComRef. This sampling results in lists used by the Controller to send invitations to participate.

The processing operations on personal data linked to the management of this consultation are necessary for the functioning of the Commission as mandated by the Treaties, and more specifically by Articles 5 and 13 TEU and Articles 244 - 250 TFEU.
