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State of play since launch of 21 April 2016

- More than 150 health interest groups registered;
- More than 500 registered users overall;
- Agora, four Thematic Networks and 23 networks of Commission expert and stakeholder groups;
- Also used by other international organisations: Steering Group of the WHO European Health Information Initiative.

Web-Platform: a tool under development

Recently added functionalities:

- Notifications to the members of networks about newly uploaded information;
- Bulk upload of documents

To follow:

- Revision of the Homepage to simplify access and better guide users
