# ProMIS - Mattone Internazionale Salute Programme

ProMIS was created in 2011 and institutionalized in 2015, in response to the need to **exploit know-how and dissemination of good practices** in the context of decentralized health cooperation and global health. ProMIS also aims to promote Italy's **participation in European funding and projects** and to build a constant and qualified presence of Italy in the European and international health framework. We are constantly collaborating with national ministries, National Health Agencies and Institutes. ProMIS supports all Italian regions in the **management of EU projects** and undertakes **communication and dissemination activities** regarding the European health and social issues.



# Input from WHO

The report "**WHO global strategy on people-centered and integrated health services**" identifies five interconnected strategic directions:

- 1) empowering & engaging people
- 2) strengthening governance & accountability
- 3) reorienting the model of care
- 4) coordinating services
- 5) creating enabling environment

whose assumption is that the **implementation of people-centred and integrated health services can generate significant benefits in all countries**, whether low, middle or high income.



# Global challenges

## Epidemiological transformations:

- ➔ **have changed the healthcare needs** (chronic diseases nowadays need dedicated social and health services)
- ➔ **underline the importance of a deep reorganization of essential services and the set-up of innovative services** undertaken within the local communities/population by professionals with specialized skills and competences.

# The Italian framework

- The **National Chronicity Plan** (NCP – 2016) underlines the importance of:
  - 1) the integration between primary and specialized care, hospital and territorial services and the activation of multidisciplinary networks and integrated social-health models;
  - 2) an integrated approach from the early stages of taking care of the chronic patient.

A **national direction** was set up to monitor the implementation of the NCP within the Italian Regions.

Finally, in the framework of ProMIS – **Mattone Internazionale Salute Programme** a dedicated sub-group of Italian Regions activated a **specific group on integrated care services**, with a main focus on frailty people.



# The Scope of INCASO Joint Statement

- ✦ To establish a common vocabulary to define issues linked to organizational innovation
- ✦ To define the specific priorities and interests by creating synergies at European level and collecting information on areas where the Italian regions are investing
- ✦ To map good practices relating to the integrated care services carry out by all European regions



# Objectives

The objectives of the Joint Statement will be:

- ❑ **To promote the exchange of European good practices at national/European level with regard to the organisational and managerial innovation of integrated services** with the aim of developing and enhancing the quality of the integrated person-centred assistance in a context as close to a patients home environment as possible. The activities to achieve these objectives are:
  - Mapping of European projects and existing good practices
  - Dissemination of results via web channels
  - Organization of thematic events
  
- ❑ **To establish a common vocabulary to process shared tools to work with in organizational innovation.**

Activities to achieve these goals are:

- Collection and analysis of regional priorities, expected results and investment
  - Sharing of the materials collected with the actors involved and sharing it broadly with all the Italian Regions
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- ❑ **To collaborate with existing European Networks/partnerships (EIP-AHA, RSCN) and share strategies, policies and interventions of the Italian Regions and other Member States.**

The aim is to strengthen and make more effective the actions undertaken within the framework of integrated services at European level.

To this aim, activities include:

- Position paper elaboration
- Proposals for recommendations to be submitted at European level
- Survey processing and data analysis
