Ranking of best practices by MSs



Marketplace

30 June – 1 July 2021



- 42 proposals were submitted after the open call
- 16 proposals were validated as best practices
- 10 best practices were presented in the Marketplace
- 3 high scoring best practices have been selected for implementation via 2 Joint Actions



Two Joint Actions on NCD prevention

• 1 - JA on diabetes type 2: implementing best practice 'Reverse Diabetes2 Now' (EUR 4 million)

• 2 - JA on promoting healthy lifestyles: implementing two best practices 'Smart Family' and 'Grünau moves' (EUR 3 million)



Joint Action on Diabetes 2

Expected Impact

- using less medication and/or
- having healthier blood glucose levels and/or
- achieving remission when possible and/or
- improving quality of life in people with diabetes type 2

Budget: EUR 4 000 000



Joint Action for Healthy lifestyle

Expected Impact

- promoting healthy lifestyles in families with children to prevent obesity
- increasing physical activity and healthy diet in children and families with a focus on social norms, recognition and self-esteem in deprived district (health equality)

Budget: EUR 3 000 000

packages)	
Opening for submissions	15 November
Deadline for submissions	15 February 2022
