Child Protection



- ◆ **specialized child protection services** to UASCY (drop-in, emergency response, individual case-management and psychosocial support, medical and mental health counselling services and psychosocial group activities to UASCY regardless of their registration or case status)
- ◆ **legal assistance** to UASCY
- ◆ **education and professional development opportunities** with appropriate psychosocial support to UASCY

Areas of Intervention

Direct assistance



- ◆ **localized assistance** to migrants in transit including medical, socioeconomic assistance, education and housing assistance for vulnerable migrants
- ◆ **distribution of non-food items** to migrants in need
- ◆ **Voluntary Return and Reintegration (AVRR) programme** for migrants in transit to their country of origin
- ◆ **organization of soft skills trainings** for AVRR beneficiaries

Capacity building



- ◆ **trainings** for community health volunteers and migrant community leaders

1,212 **vulnerable migrants** benefitted from direct assistance

296 **migrants** benefitted from AVRR assistance

600 **among adult and children migrants** received non-food items kits

500 **Sudanese returnees** benefitted from job and community fair event in Sudan

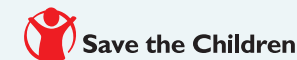

Areas of Intervention

Child protection



- ◆ **case management, psychological support** to children and parents
- ◆ **promoting the access to a quality education** for refugees, migrants and children asylum seekers through teachers' trainings
- ◆ **renovation of school premises** and distribution of school materials to vulnerable children
- ◆ **promoting the scholar integration** of unaccompanied and separated minors through teachers' trainings, literacy and calculus programmes, language classes (Arabic and English)

Capacity building



- ◆ **creation of new job sustainable opportunities** through professional counselling, professional training, entrepreneurship courses and creation of partnerships with the private sector
- ◆ **trainings to humanitarian agencies** in the field of management of children at risk of violence

Awareness raising



- ◆ **promoting a greater social participation** and community involvement in the promotion of children's rights through awareness raising campaigns and organization of events at a community level

Main results achieved until January 2020

- 777** **cases of minors,** victims or at risk of violence managed
- 307** **children** attended L&N classes or ALP or Language Programs
- 296** **people** identified and benefitted of individual psychosocial support granted by psychologists
- 5** **community learning centres** renovated and supported with new furniture
- 73** **NGO's and international agencies' staff members** trained in the field of minor safeguard, PSS, Case Management and safe programming – 4 training cycles
- 80** **teachers** trained on new teaching methodologies
- 290** **parents** involved in training and life-skills and awareness activities
- 89** **UASC** received vocational trainings and employability related trainings
- 1,150** **educational kits** distributed

Areas of Intervention

Registration, documentation and Refugee Status Determination (RSD)



- including **special procedures** for the safeguard of unaccompanied and separated children (UASC)

Child protection



- prevention and response activities** for children at risk, with specific focus on UASC

Capacity building



- trainings for government officials** on International Refugee Law and international protection

Awareness raising



- dissemination of information** on international protection and on pacific coexistence

Direct assistance



- legal assistance and humanitarian support** (food and medical assistance) to refugees and asylum-seekers

Main results achieved until December 2019

133,375 **people** were newly registered

29,454 **decisions** on the Refugee Status Determination (RSD) finalized

Average waiting period for registration and merged registration/ RSD procedure reduced between **41 and 133 days** depending on the nationality of asylum-seekers.

The fast-track registration procedure for persons with specific vulnerabilities, including unaccompanied children and children at risk, has been enhanced and it is conducted within **72 hours**

534 **unaccompanied and separated children (UASC)** have received comprehensive assessment and response

2,124 **refugees and asylum-seekers** received legal assistance

4,192 **detainees/asylum-seekers** received food and medical assistance

1,181 **government officials** trained on international protection and International Refugee Law principles
