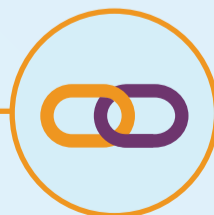

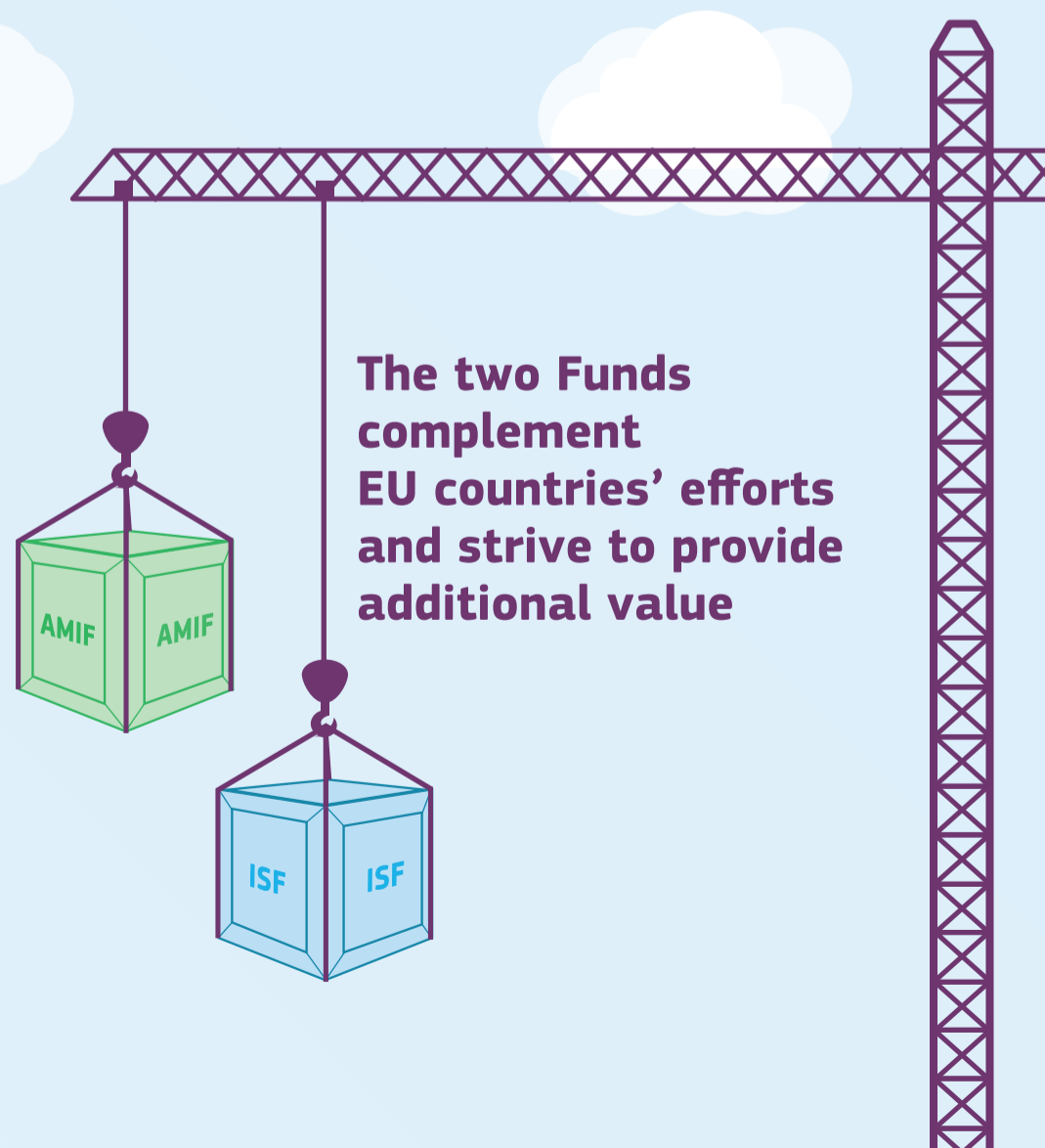

Asylum

- ensure a uniform and high-quality asylum policy within the EU
- apply higher standards of international protection
- support efforts made in terms of resettlement



Legal migration and integration

- facilitate legal migration to the EU
- promote the integration of persons from outside the EU at national, local and regional levels
- support measures to fight irregular migration



Return

- improve the management of return of non-EU nationals in all its dimensions
- promote voluntary return



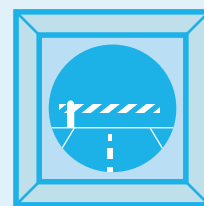
Solidarity

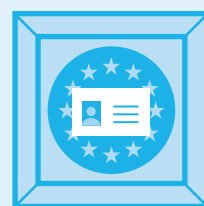

Borders

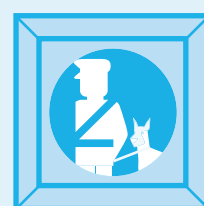
- integrated border management for a uniform and high standard of control of the external borders

Visa

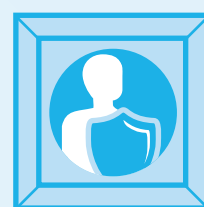
- facilitate legitimate travel to the EU

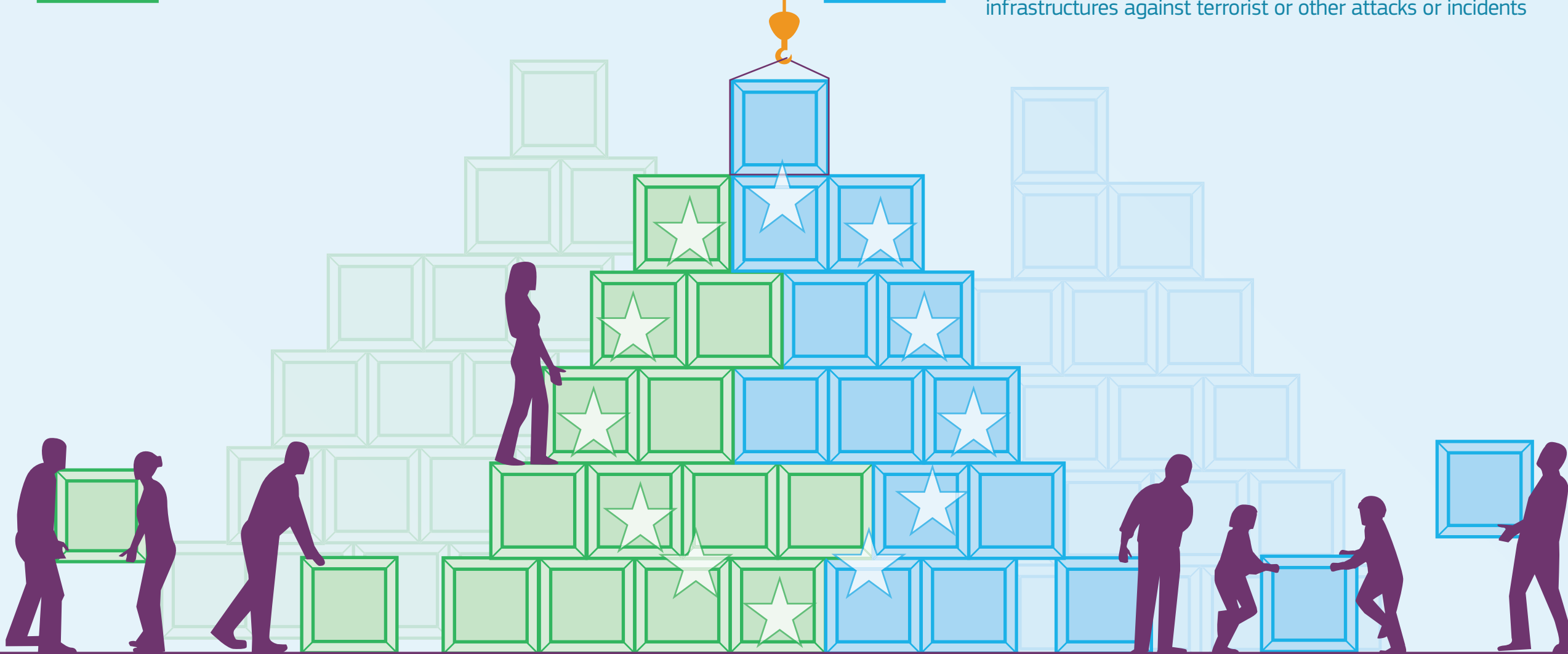
Fight against crime

- reinforce coordination and cooperation between EU law enforcement actors and other authorities, including Europol and other relevant organisations

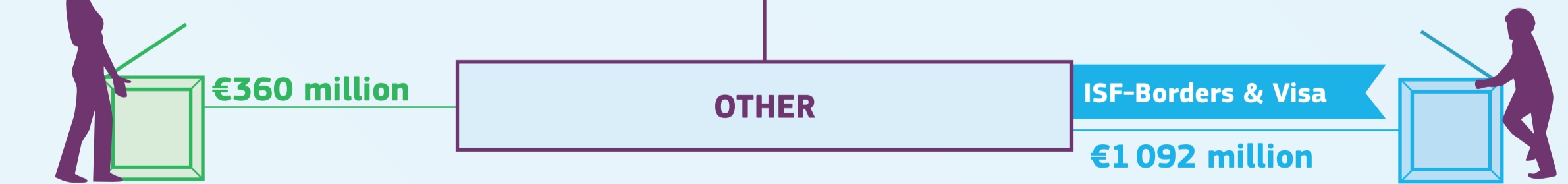
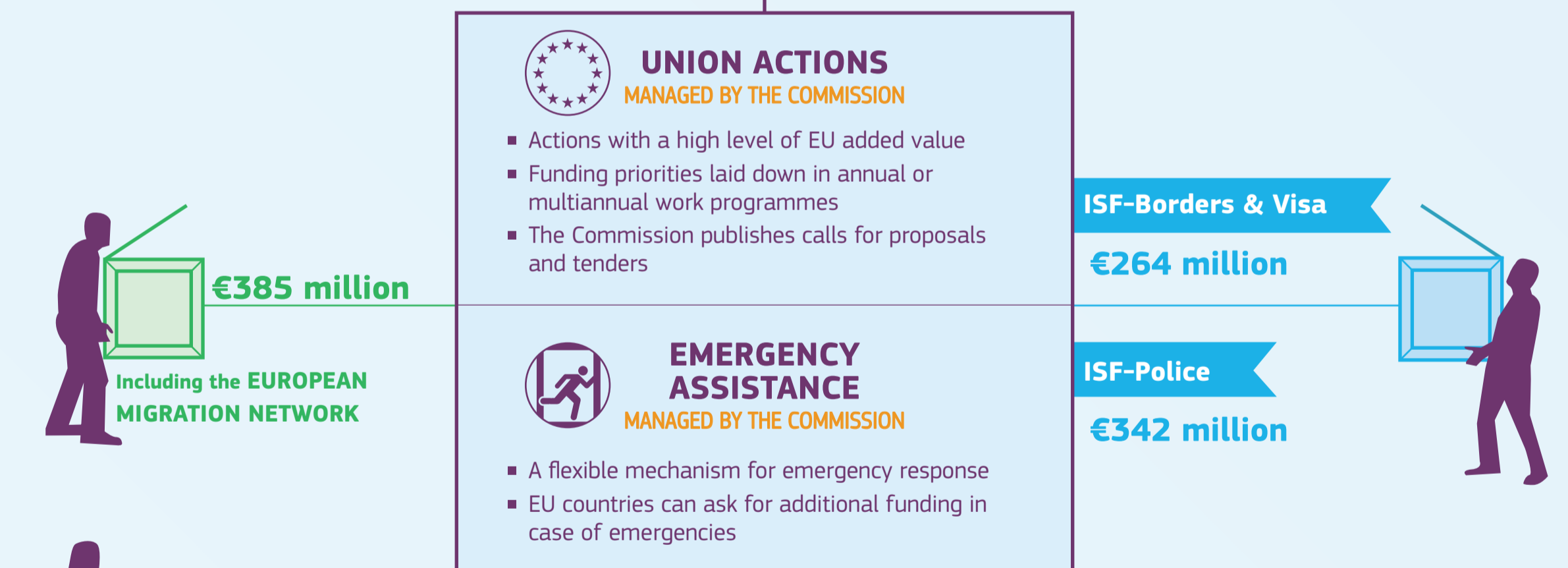
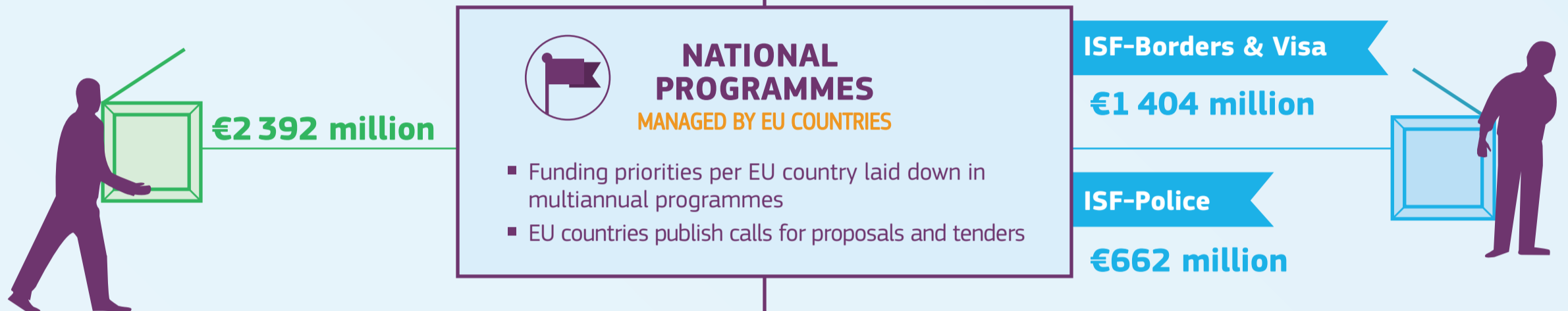
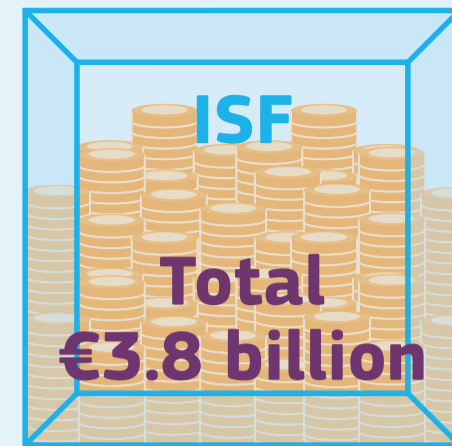


Managing risks and crises

MEANS TO ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES



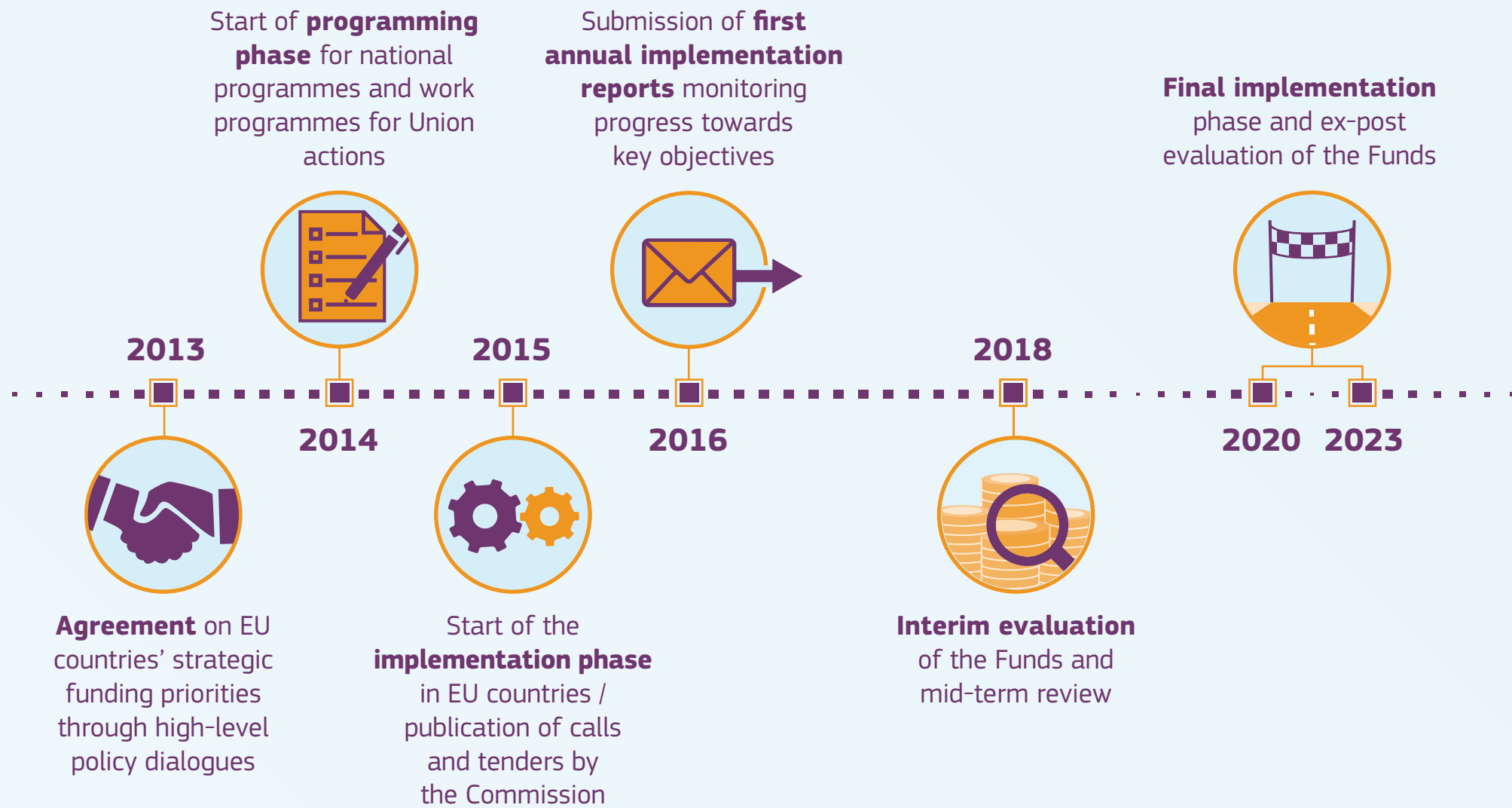
Including UNION RESETTLEMENT PROGRAMME
