

List of measures to implement Regulation (EU) 98/2013 on explosives precursors in the EU/EEA

Austria	Ordinance (Ausgangsstoffverordnung BGBl II Nr. 31/2015) established a registration regime for three substances.
Belgium	A ban is in place. Law of 15 July 2016 implementing Regulation (EU) 98/2013 lays down rules.
Bulgaria	A ban is in place. Decree № 283 of 29.12.2015 lays down rules.
Croatia	The Law on the implementation of Regulation EU 98/2013 (Narodne novine broj: 41/2016 02.05.2016) established a registration regime for three substances.
Cyprus	A ban is in place. The Law of 15 July 2016 [C-2016/11317] and Law 26(I)/2017 lay down rules.
Czech Republic	Act No. 259/2014 Coll. established a licensing and registration regime.
Denmark	Act no. 1623 of 26 December 2013 and Order no. 956 of 28 August 2014 maintain a pre-existing licensing regime.
Estonia	A ban is in place. The Chemicals Act of 29.10.2015 lays down rules.
Finland	Law 653/2014 established a licensing regime.
France	Law 2016-731 of 3 June 2016 established a registration regime.
Germany	The Chemicals Prohibition Ordinance (ChemVerbotsV) maintains a registration regime.
Greece	A ban is in place. The Joint Ministerial Decision . reg.no 23056/ΔTBN 464/(Gazet. Off. 687 B' 16.3.2016) lays down rules on penalties.
Hungary	Decree 274/2016 of 15 September 2016 established a registration regime.
Ireland	Statutory Instrument No. 611 of 2014 established a licensing regime.
Italy	A ban is in place. Rules on penalties are laid down by L. 17 April 2015, n. 43 (Gazet. Off. 20 April 2015, n. 91.)
Latvia	A ban is in place. Rules on penalties are laid down in the Criminal Law and the Latvian Administrative Infringements Code.
Lithuania	Measures have been adopted which establish a registration regime.
Luxembourg	A ban is in place. Mémorial A n° 484 of 12 May 2017 lays down rules.
Malta	L.N. 359 of 2014 Product Safety Act (Cap. 427) established a combined registration and licensing regime for three substances.
Netherlands	The Law on explosives precursors established a licensing regime.
Norway	A ban is in place. Regulation 588 of 2 June 2015 lays down rules.
Poland	A ban is in place. Law of 13 April 2016 on the safety of trading in explosives precursors lays down rules.
Portugal	Decree-law nº 56/2016 of 29.08.2016 established a licensing regime.
Romania	A ban is in place.

Slovakia	Act 262 of 10 September 2014 established a licensing and registration regime for three substances.
Slovenia	A ban is in place. Decree No. 28/2016 of 15.04.2016 lays down rules.
Spain	A ban is in place.
Sweden	Lag (2014:799) om sprängämnesprekursorer established a licensing regime for three substances.
United Kingdom	Poisons Act 1972 [as amended] and Statutory Rule No. 224 of 2014 (for Northern Ireland) established a licensing regime.
