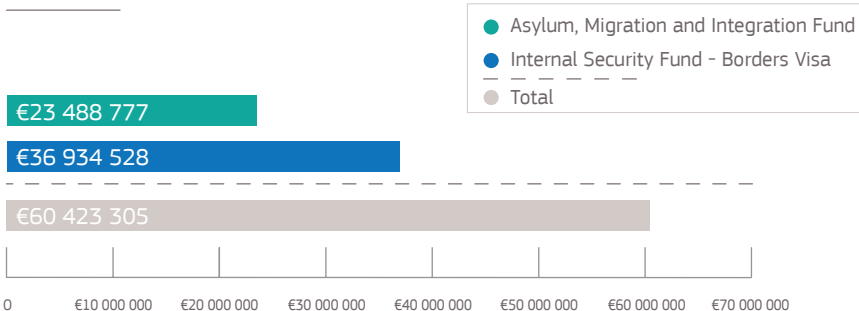


# Funding in the areas of migration and border management

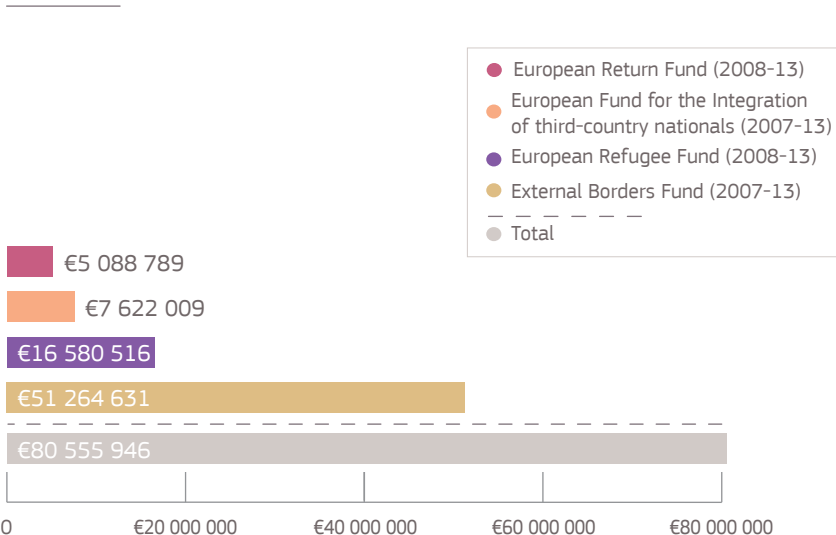
The EU provides Member States with financial resources to support efforts in the areas of legal and irregular migration, return, asylum, border management and integration. During the 2014-20 period, the principal EU financial instruments supporting these areas are the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the Internal Security Fund – Borders and Visa, under which €3.6 billion are allocated directly to Member States. Emergency assistance is also available to Member States throughout this new funding period. During the period 2007-13, the previous financial framework allocated €3.7 billion (including emergency assistance) via four Funds: the European Fund for the Integration of third-country nationals, the European Refugee Fund, the European Return Fund and the External Borders Fund.

## PROJECT EXAMPLE

### Representative – training for the representatives of the young asylum seekers who arrived alone (UAM/guardianship)

Beneficiary: Center for Continuing Education  
Annual Programme: 2012  
Project cost: €70 000  
EU funding: €52 000

This project helped train and strengthen the expertise of 18 representatives for unaccompanied minors thus contributing to the children's best interest and the enforcement of their rights.

### Improving aircraft operational performance

Beneficiary: The Finnish Border Guard  
Annual Programme: 2007  
Project cost: €66 000  
EU funding: €49 500

Funding was used to update surveillance technology used in helicopters. The surveillance technology is used to detect prohibited border crossings in the coastal and border areas and to carry out "search and rescue" and environmental protection duties.
