

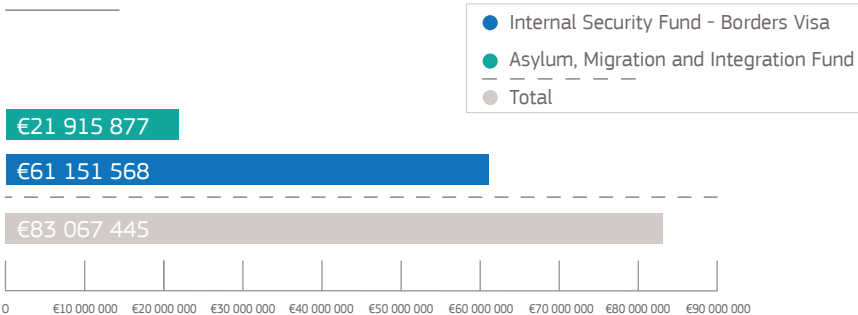


Funding in the areas of migration and border management

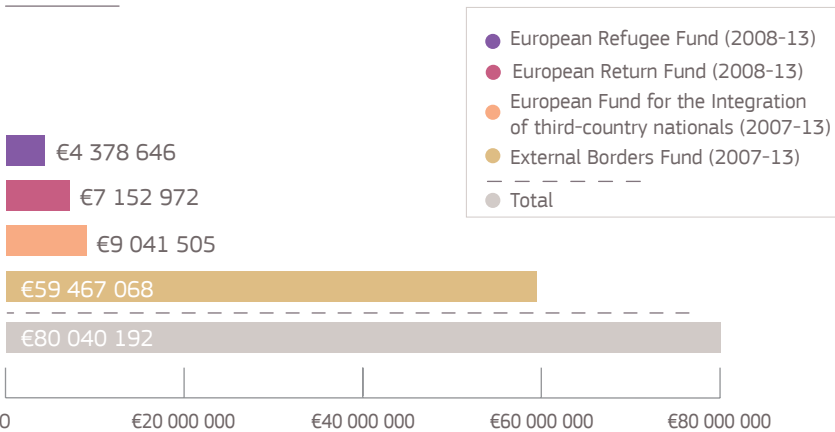
The EU provides Member States with financial resources to support efforts in the areas of legal and irregular migration, return, asylum, border management and integration. During the 2014-20 period, the principal EU financial instruments supporting these areas are the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the Internal Security Fund – Borders and Visa, under which €3.6 billion are allocated directly to Member States. Emergency assistance is also available to Member States throughout this new funding period. During the period 2007-13, the previous financial framework allocated €3.7 billion (including emergency assistance) via four Funds: the European Fund for the Integration of third-country nationals, the European Refugee Fund, the European Return Fund and the External Borders Fund.

“Integrated Border surveillance” – Halmeu border sector

Annual Programme: 2010

The surveillance system covers 35 kilometres of border with Ukraine and aims to facilitate the detection of illegal border crossing and to reduce intervention time in the border perimeter.
