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CEF eInvoicing

The CEF eInvoicing building block will promote the uptake and accelerate the use of eInvoicing respecting the European standard (publication due Q2,2017), amongst both public and private entities established in the EU, as well as in participating EEA countries.

CEF eInvoicing: 2015 call

- **Budget:** €7 million
- **Co-funding rate:** The maximum co-financing rates of EU financial assistance to be granted under this call for proposals will not exceed 75% of eligible costs of the action
- **Indicative duration:** 1 year

CEF eInvoicing: Legal framework

❖ Directive 2014/55/EU on eInvoicing in public procurement calls for:

- European eInvoicing standard to be developed and tested by CEN
- All public administrations in the EU obliged to receive and process electronic invoices compliant with the new standard by latest 27 November 2019

BUT:

- Publication of the European standard in Q2 2017
- Possibility to postpone deadline for regional and local authorities for a further 12 months

Scope:

- Only invoices covered by EU Public Procurement Directives
- Only invoices submitted to the public sector
- Covers all public authorities (national, regional, local)

CEF eInvoicing: Objectives

- Through grants, CEF Telecom seeks to promote the uptake and accelerate the use of eInvoicing
- Uptake of eInvoicing in public procurement is supported by CEF eInvoicing on the Core Service Platform via the provision of a **"match-making" Website, Test Infrastructure, Support** and finally **connectivity to the CEF eDelivery building block DSI**

CEF eInvoicing: Objectives

- The appropriate technical solutions and organisational set up must be in place to facilitate eInvoicing
- Priority will be given to eInvoicing solutions that are **already on the market**
- Priority will be given to projects which allow **cross-border exchanges**

CEF eInvoicing: Objectives

- The preferred solutions should be based on **existing technical specifications** developed within the **framework of European standardisation organisations** such as CEN
- The preferred solutions should also **take into account the results of large-scale pilot projects** like PEPPOL

CEF eInvoicing: Eligibility

- Proposals can be submitted by one or more Member State(s) or a consortium consisting of at least **five entities** from one or more Member State(s) composed of public or private entities, **at least half of which should be public.**
