Most projects are implementing **large scale infrastructure**.

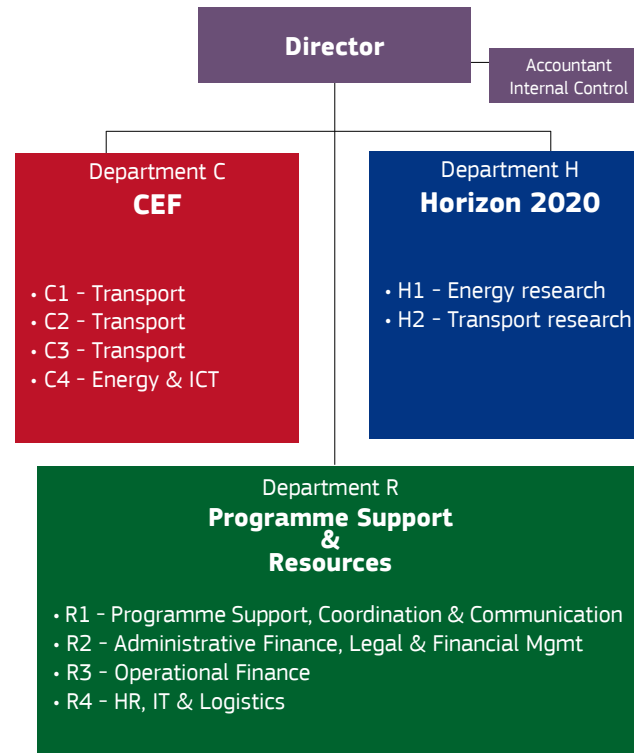
About you
