## Objectives

The call supports the timely and efficient completion of a number of TEN-T projects in their entirety or in significant parts, together with the realisation of a robust and resource efficient European transport system.

### €1.4 billion available

Under the **General** envelope:

#### €750 million

- Core Network Corridors and Other sections of the Core Network

€500 million

- Safe and secure infrastructure

€20 million

- European Rail Traffic Management System (ERTMS)

€50 million

- Intelligent Transport Services for road (ITS)

€20 million

- Single European Sky (SESAR)

€20 million

- Urban Nodes

€110 million

- Motorways of the Sea

€30 million

Under the **Cohesion\*** envelope:

#### €650 million

- Core Network Corridors and Other sections of the Core Network

€610 million

- Safe and secure infrastructure

€40 million

\* The Cohesion envelope is reserved for the 15 EU Member States that are eligible for Cohesion Fund support.

## What projects are eligible for funding?

A proposal submitted under this call must address works or studies, depending on the priority specification in the Work Programme.

## Who can apply?

Two types of applicants can submit their proposal:

- One or more Member States
- With the agreement of the Member State(s) concerned, international organisations, joint undertakings, or public or private undertakings or bodies established in an EU Member State

## How to apply?

- Read the call documentation on the call page
- Obtain approval of the Member State(s) concerned
- Prepare your application in the TENtec eSubmission module
- Submit your application online via the TENtec eSubmission module before 26 February 2020 at 17:00.00 Brussels time
