### COMPUTER SECURITY INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAMS (CSIRTs)

Teams that provide services to handle cybersecurity incidents and support their constituents to recover from incidents

Public bodies responsible for the security of network and information systems of a country



### OPERATORS OF ESSENTIAL SERVICES (OESs)

Entities that provide services that are critical to the functioning of a State e.g. in the transport and energy sectors



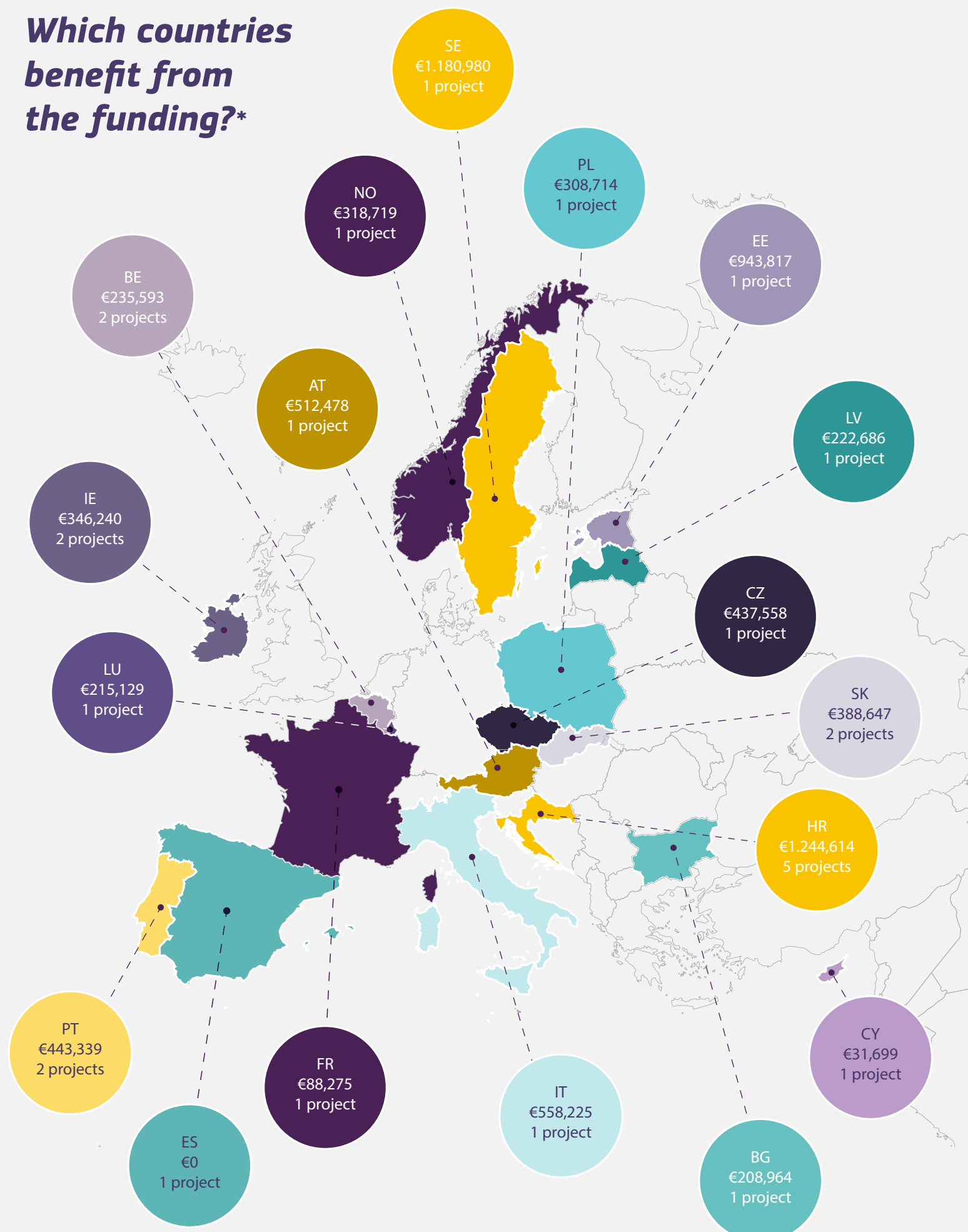
### NATIONAL CYBERSECURITY CERTIFICATION AUTHORITIES
