Most projects are carrying out **research & innovation** in the areas of transport and energy.

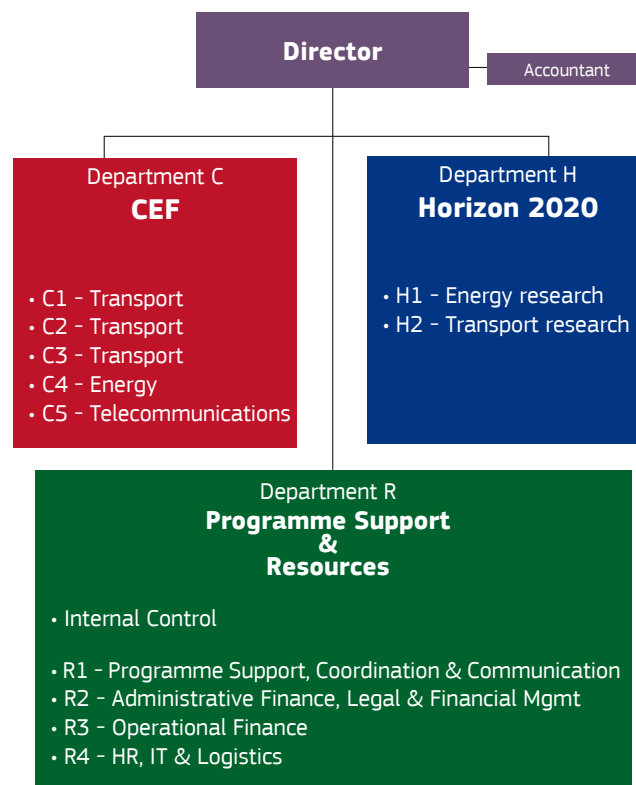
About you
