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## AMENDMENT GUIDE

 This document lists the amendment types (AT-clauses) and shows **mandatory combinations** and combinations that are often used together (**other combinations**). Additional combinations may be needed to suit your case.

The list of supporting documents covers required documents for the clause in question AND its mandatory combinations. For those linked to other combinations, see those other clauses.

For any questions related to an amendment request, please contact us immediately (via your [Funding & Tenders Portal account](#) > My Project(s) > Actions > Manage Project > Process communications) so that we can see how to solve the problem. Incomplete or incorrect amendment requests will be rejected and will have to be re-submitted (it is not possible to change amendment requests, once signed).

Clauses are implemented as:

1. Automatic (change of system data by Consortium/PO automatically triggers AT-clause)
2. Selected by EU or beneficiary (AT-clause must be selected on the Amendment Information screen by the Consortium/PO)
3. On-demand (AT-clause must be requested from Helpdesk – please contact your Project Officer).


Clauses in **grey** are open only to the EU (and can therefore NOT be activated by you). Please contact your Project Officer.

For changes linked to errors/mistakes, some standard clauses can be flagged as *Error amendment* type by the EU Officers. Amendment clauses that can be marked as *Error amendment* are listed below. For any other specific circumstances, the general error AT60 clause must be used. Please contact your Project Officer.
