## **Guidance note – Methodology for expert fees for remote evaluation and ethics review**

### **1. Methodology**

The EU expert model contracts use a simplified methodology to determine the **amounts and working days for the remote work** of expert evaluators.

The fees for remote work are composed of different **unit costs per task and proposal/prize application**, in accordance with the tables set out below.

The unit costs were determined on the basis of the cost per working day used previously (and also used for experts under Decision C(2007)5858<sup>1</sup>). Those costs were broken down into a rate per work unit (*i.e.* EUR 45 per work unit; 10 work units are equivalent to EUR 450; 10 work units are equivalent to 1 working day) and each task was given the number of work units that correspond to the working time normally required for it.

The resulting breakdown of fees allows for a simple and straightforward remuneration of the different tasks to be performed remotely during evaluations.

The tasks and fees will be **fixed in advance for each expert** in their contract and will apply automatically, depending on the number of tasks assigned.

The contract will moreover set out the additional conditions that must be fulfilled (together with the call for expression of interest, the code of conduct and the terms of reference).

The unit costs cover remote evaluation for both **grants and prizes** and **ethics review**. They do not apply to observers.
