



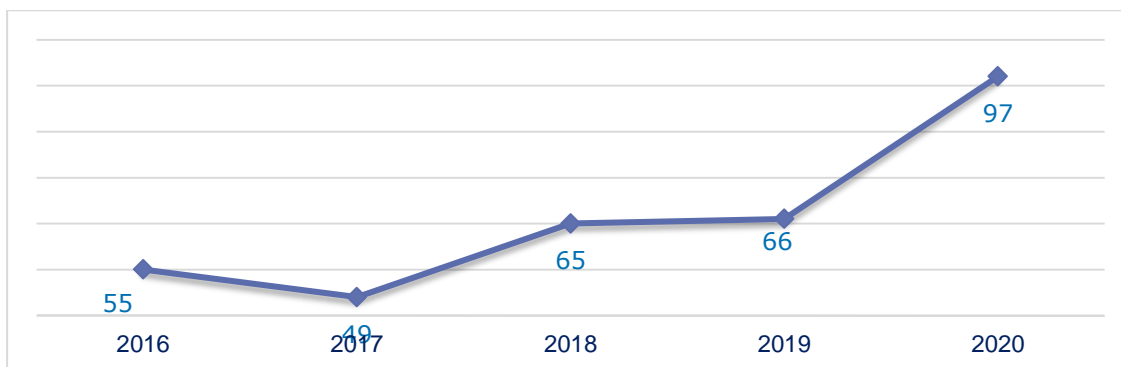

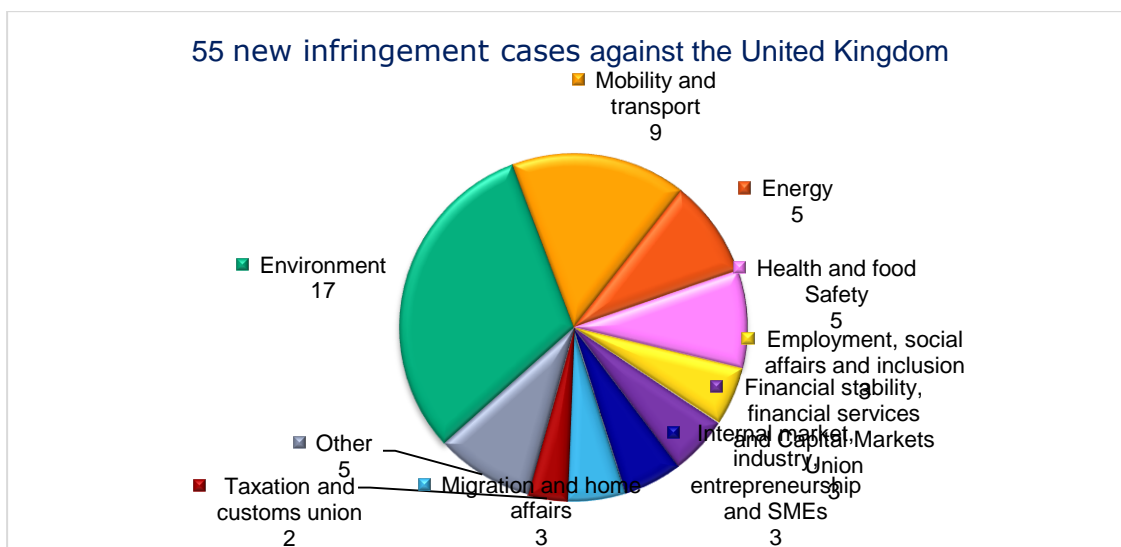
2020 Annual Report

'On 1 February 2020, the Withdrawal Agreement setting out arrangements for the orderly withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the Union entered into force and the United Kingdom became formally a third country. The Withdrawal Agreement provided for a transition period which started on 1 February 2020 and ended on 31 December 2020. During that transition period, and unless otherwise provided, Union law continued to apply to and in the United Kingdom, including infringement procedures. Any reference to Member States in this report should therefore be understood as including the United Kingdom.'

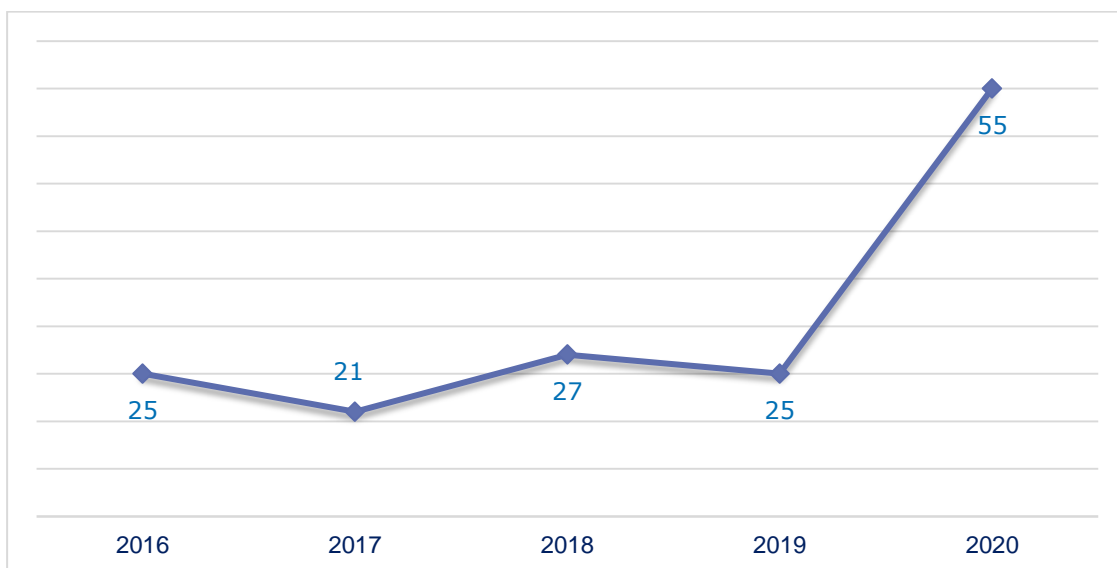
Infringement cases against the United Kingdom open on 31 December (2016-2020)



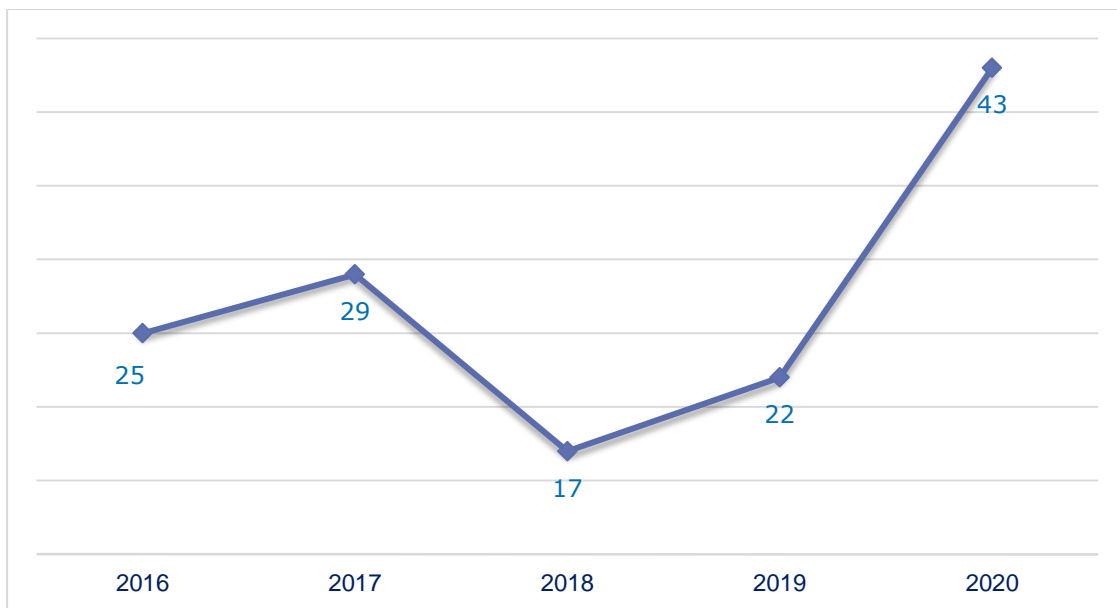
New infringement cases opened in 2020: main policy areas



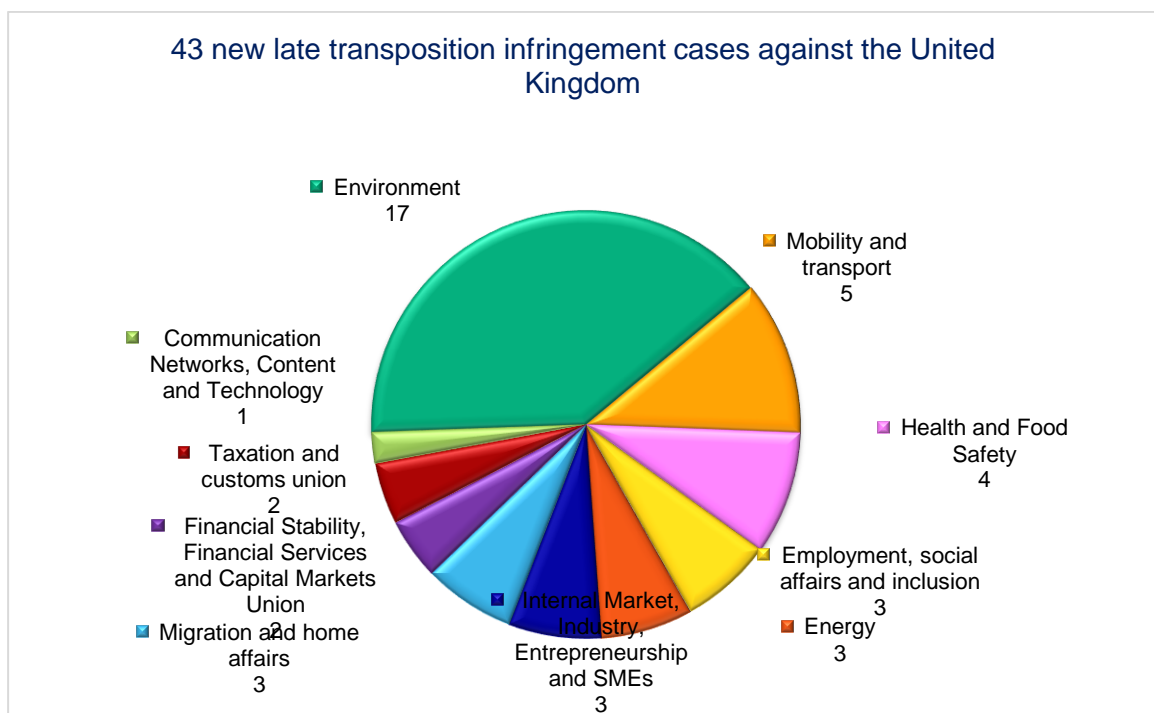
Late transposition infringement cases against the United Kingdom open on 31 December (2016-2020)
