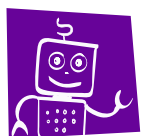

Join live sessions with interesting speakers talking about the future of European research and innovation, and Horizon Europe, the new EU-funded Programme on research and innovation.

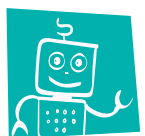
