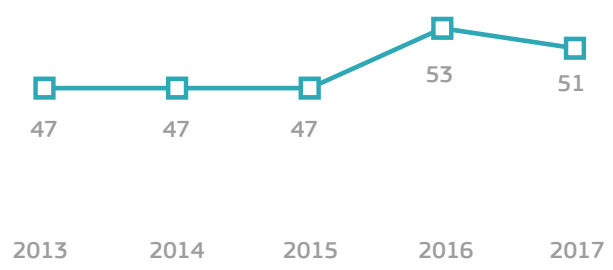




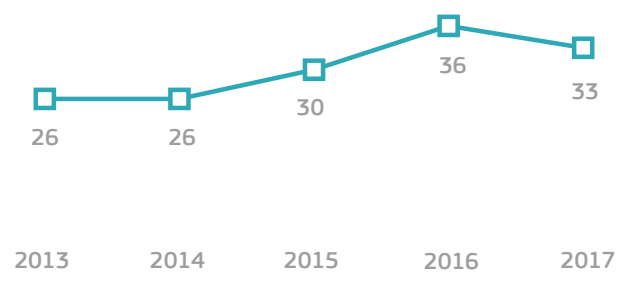

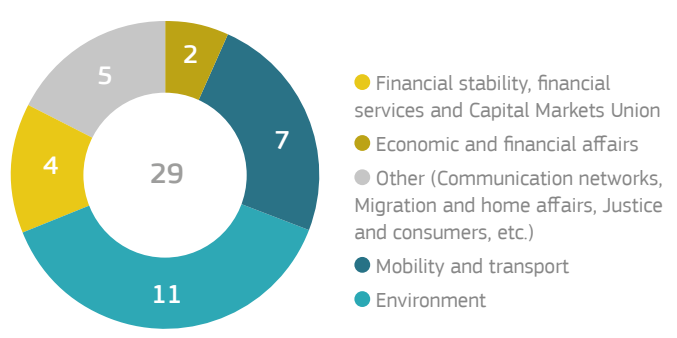
Infringement cases open as of 31 December 2017



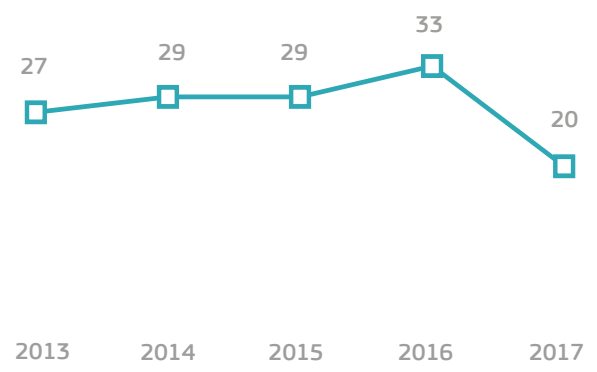
Late transposition¹ infringement cases

Relevant rulings of the European Courts:

1. *The Court of Justice of the EU ruled that Slovenia has failed to ensure appropriate storage and landfill of waste tyres in Lovrenc na Dravskem polju, in breach of EU directives on waste³.*

2. *In preliminary rulings, the Court ruled, amongst others, that the transfer of an asylum-seeker to the Member State responsible for examining the asylum application cannot go ahead if it might result in a risk of the person concerned suffering inhuman or degrading treatment. The transfer of an asylum-seeker with a particularly serious mental or physical illness that would risk worsening that person's health would constitute inhuman and degrading treatment⁴.*
