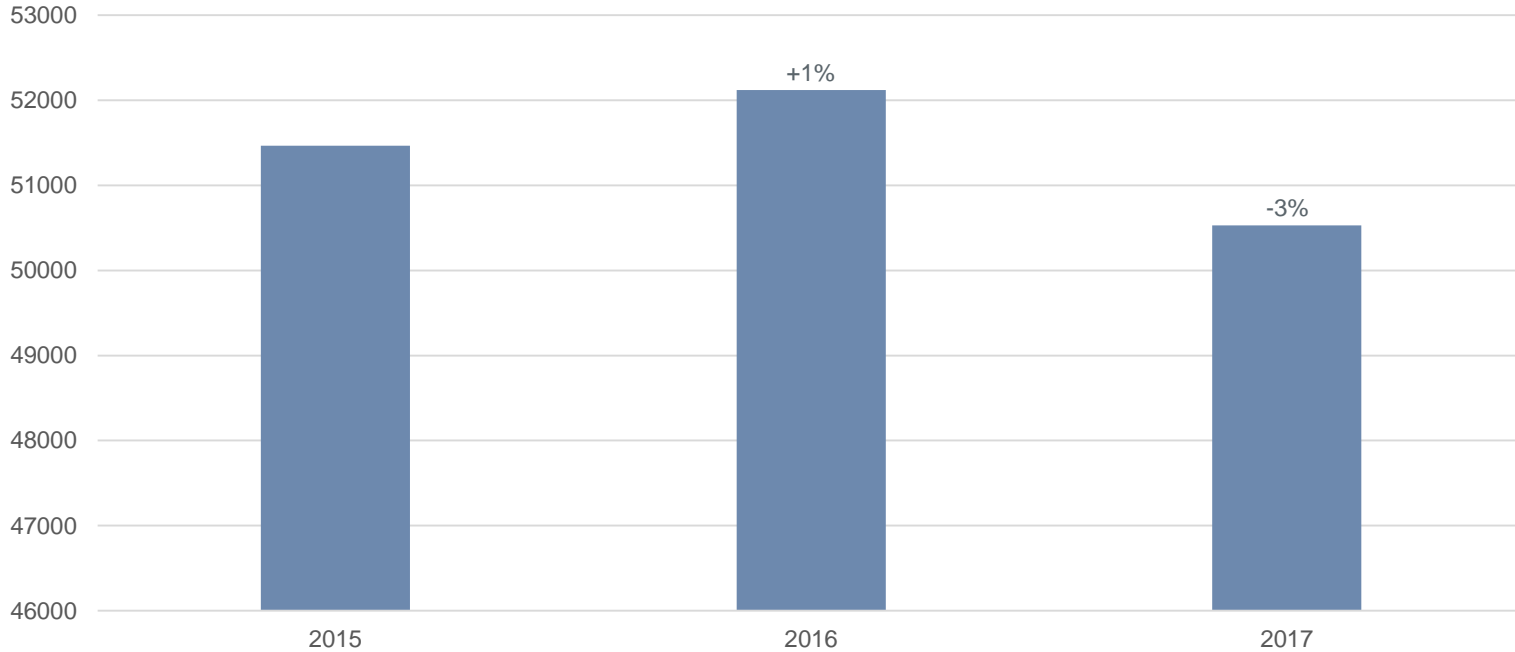

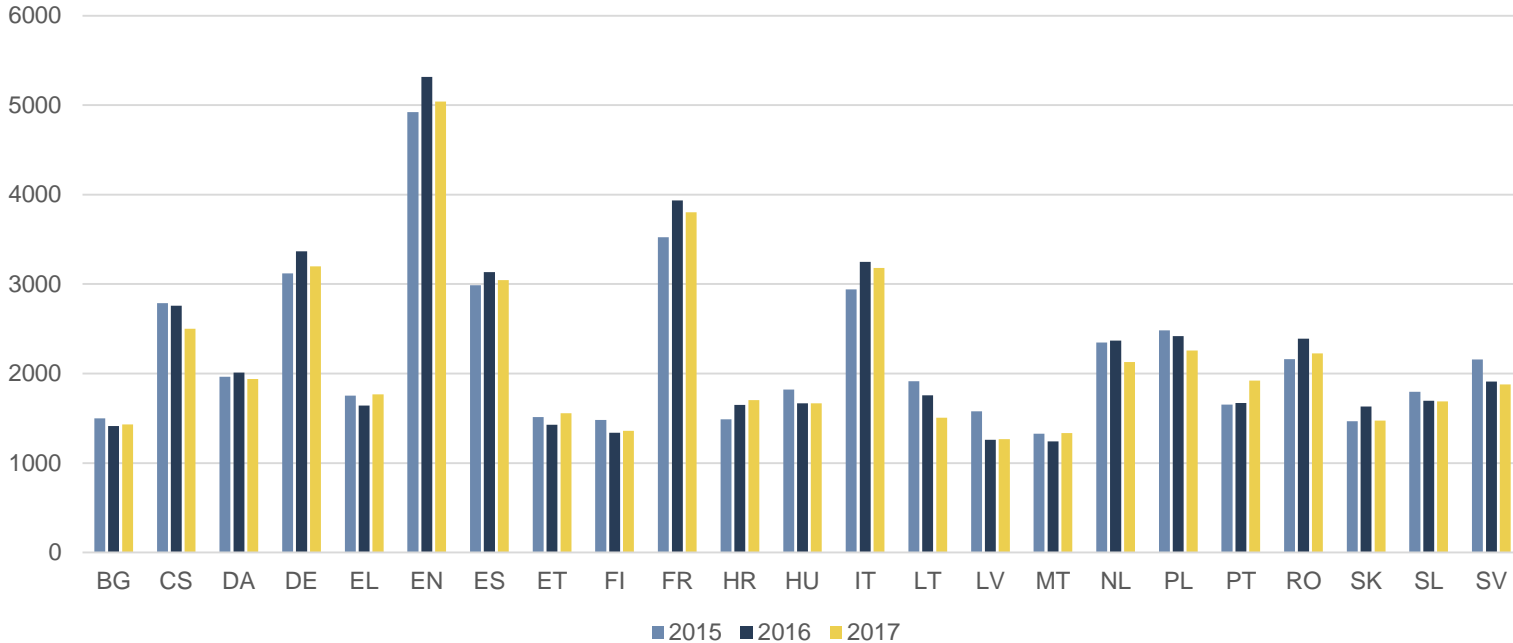

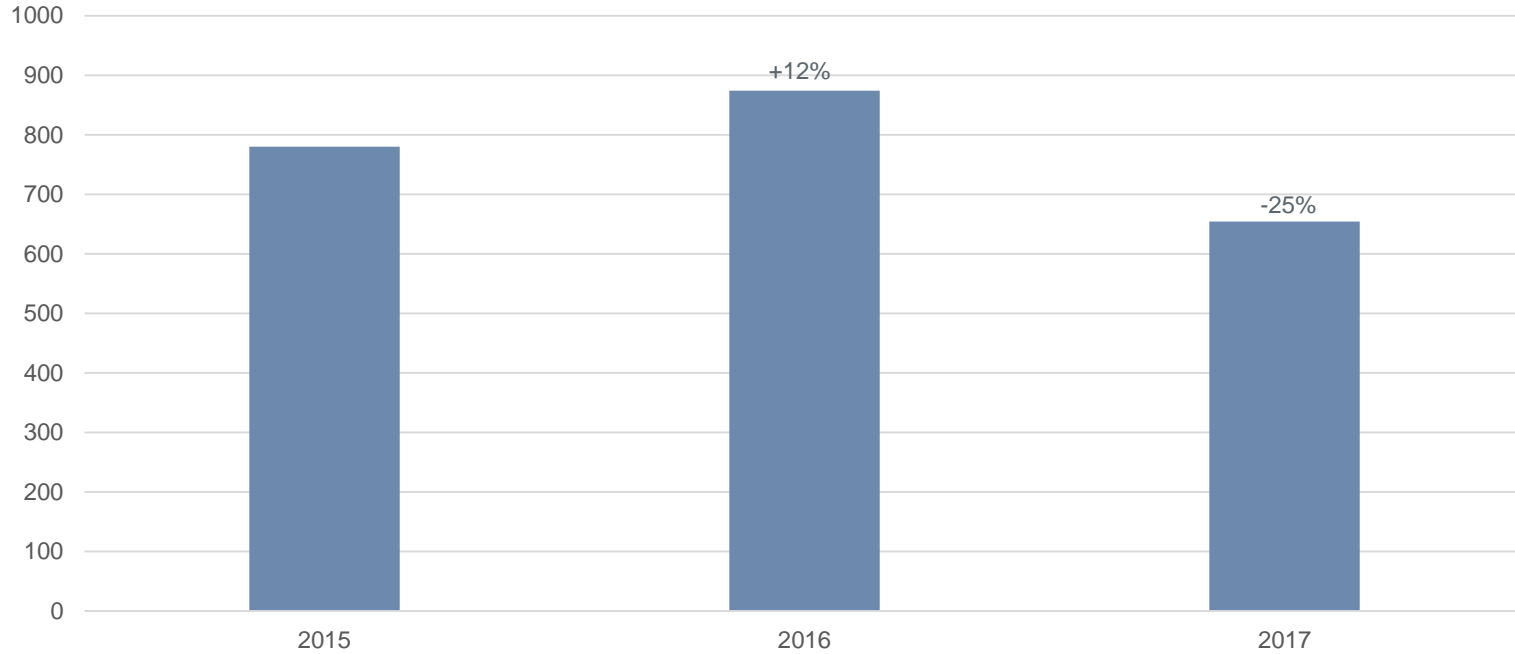
## ALL LANGUAGES 2015-2017 (ACI CONTRACT DAYS)



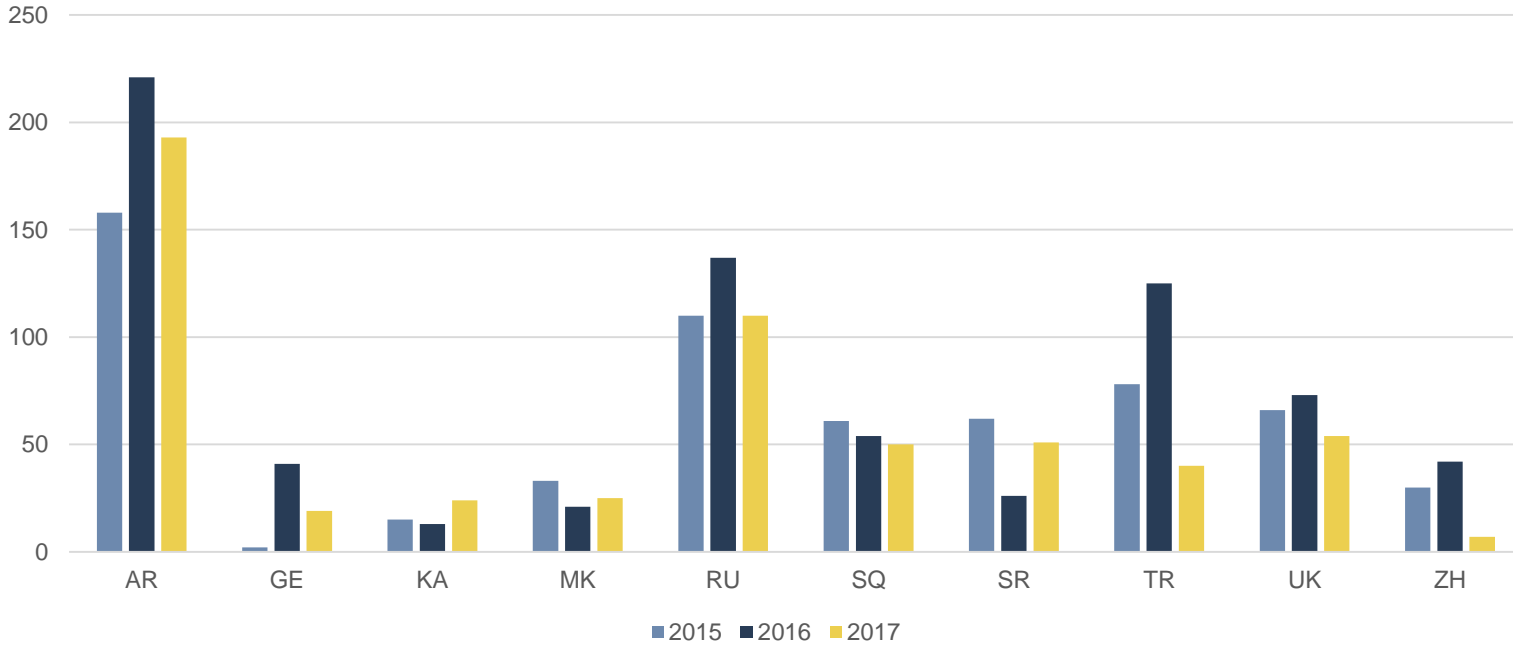
