



Reinforcing the reception capacity for refugees and migrants in Greece

for the Ministry of Migration Policy

The Commission is supporting national authorities with **reinforcing their institutional and operational capacity to provide appropriate reception conditions and services to newly arriving migrants and asylum seekers.**



Context

Greece is gradually building a **state run reception system**. The authorities responsible for the reception and services for newly arrived asylum seekers requested technical support in order to transition to the new system.

Support delivered

The support provided with the office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees as implementing partner for 17 months aims at:

- **assessing** gaps and best practices on which to build an action plan;
- **developing a regulatory and legislative framework** as well as harmonising, systemising and monitoring reception conditions; and
- **training officials.**

Expected results

The support from the SRSS is expected to deliver the following results:

- **improve reception conditions and procedures;** and
- **establish a sustainable system for accommodation and cash assistance** for asylum seekers.

And to have the following impact:

- **enhanced accommodation, services and assistance** for asylum seekers.
