



Labour migration strategy in Poland

for the Ministry of Investment and Economic Development (in cooperation with the Ministry of Family, Labour and Social Policy)

The Commission is supporting national authorities in their efforts to **develop a comprehensive and sustainable labour migration policy framework.**



Context

Poland is developing a migration strategy to **address the challenges of an ageing population, a growing labour demand**, and substantial **emigration** in particular of young citizens. The strategy is to be implemented over the next couple of years.

Support delivered

The support, delivered over a period of **18 months**, consists mainly of:

- carrying out **research and analysis** of labour migration and retention measures;
- providing **recommendations** to support policy implementation;
- organising **country visits** to learn about selected measures adopted in other countries; and **expert seminars** to discuss their applicability to the Polish context.

Expected results

Support from the SRSS delivered the following results:

- **review policy measures** to steer labour migration policies and encourage the return of Polish emigrants;
- **build capacity** to monitor and evaluate migration policies;
- **enhance bilateral cooperation** on labour migration.

And to have the following impact:

- more comprehensive, evidence-based **Labour Migration Strategy.**
