ICT Policy Support Programme

- Support EU ICT policy objectives
 - Requiring wider uptake and better use of ICT by citizens, businesses, governments
 - ICT for health and inclusion (ageing population), public services, digital library, multilingualism, ICT for energy efficiency and smart mobility, trust and security etc...
- Support innovation policy objectives
 - Facilitating the development of <u>EU-wide markets for innovative</u> <u>ICT-based products and services</u>
- Focus on areas that need financial intervention at EU level
 - Importance of <u>leverage</u> effects
- Readiness of the stakeholders to mobilise financial and human resources to carry out the actions
 - EU players <u>readiness</u> to fill/respond to the intervention



ICT PSP: actions

- Develop show cases of innovative ICT based services and solutions
 - Stimulating wider deployment of these innovations
 - Addressing legal and organisational barriers
 - Supporting interoperability, reducing fragmentation, sharing risk,...
 - Pilot and best practice actions with European dimensions
 - Building on Member States initiative,
 - Stimulating uptake and best use of innovative solutions
- Analyse current, and preparing for future developments
 - Consensus and partnership building
 - Exploring new solutions and EU-wide deployment and use
- Diffuse widely the results
 - Dissemination, experience sharing in view of scalability or replication

ICT PSP: state of play

- Two Calls for proposals in 2007 and 2008, 93 M€ of funding
 - WP 2007, call1 for 54 M€ + 11 M€ for other measures
 - 22 projects launched, 86 proposals received
 - 3 Large scale pilots: eProcurement, eID management, eHealth record
 - 6 Pilots and 11 TN in eGov, eHealth, eInclusion, ...
 - Call2 / WP 2008, 40 M€ + 4.5 M€ for other measures
 - 20 project being launched, 66 proposals received
 - 1 Large scale pilot, preparing the implementation of the Services Directive
 - 13 Pilots in eGov, eInclusion, ICT for Energy Efficiency and smart mobility
 - 6 TN in eHealth, eGov, ICT for EE, Trust & Security, RFID
- WP 2009-Call3 and 3bis: ~107 M€ funding for call for proposals
 - eContentplus ended in 2008; increase of ICT PSP budget (> 100M€/year)
 - Call3 open from 29 January to 2 June 2009
 - 159 proposals evaluated last week
 - Call3bis, +7 M€ for eParticipation 5 June to 23 Sept. 2009





ICT PSP - future actions

- WP2010 under preparation
 - More focus (6 themes, with less objectives per theme-tbc)
 - No major change for the implementation aspects (instruments...)
- Next Call4 (WP2010): January to June 2010 for ~107 M€
- Call5 (WP2011) can be open earlier
- Constant increase of the annual budget till 2013
 - EU players 115 M€ in 2010 to more than 140 M€ in 2013
