eParticipation Preparatory Action

- **3 years of strong support by the EP, 12mEuro funding (2006-2008)**
- **21 trial projects**
- **70 MEPs (about 10% of total) actively involved in the projects**
- **10 national parliaments**
- **Dozens of local and regional authorities**

- **NEW:** **Call for proposals now under the umbrella of CIP ICT PSP**
