

Transposition and Infringements

It is to be noted that the Single Market *acquis* applicable in EEA EFTA States does not coincide exactly with that applicable in EU Member States. This situation is due to the time lag between the adoption or abrogation of legal acts by the EU and their incorporation into or deletion from the EEA Agreement.

Any comparison of the results from the two different Scoreboards (this one and the EEA EFTA Scoreboard) has to take this difference into account. For more information on Liechtenstein's performance, please see the EFTA Surveillance Authority's Internal Market Scoreboard.



Transposition deficit: 1.2% (*last report: 1.1%*) – just above the target 1% deficit level.

EEA EFTA average: 1.0%


Overdue directives: 11 (last report: 11) and 3 more than 2 years overdue

Average delay: 22 months (*last report: 22.7 months*) – slight decrease but still reflecting the fact that Liechtenstein has 8 directives outstanding since the previous period, one of which is overdue by over 4 years and 2 of which are overdue by over 3 years.

EEA EFTA average: 13.3 months

Compliance deficit: 0.1% (last report: 0.1%)

Problematic sectors: services (2)


Average case duration: 30 months (last report: 22.5 months)

Internal Market Information System

Performance – Lichtenstein continues to perform well.

- Liechtenstein continues to deal with a very small number of requests in a timely and efficient manner.
- Although the overall performance of Lichtenstein is very good, all 5 indicators show a slight decrease since 2014.
- The satisfaction rate among counterparts about efforts made to reply has dropped significantly in 2015.


