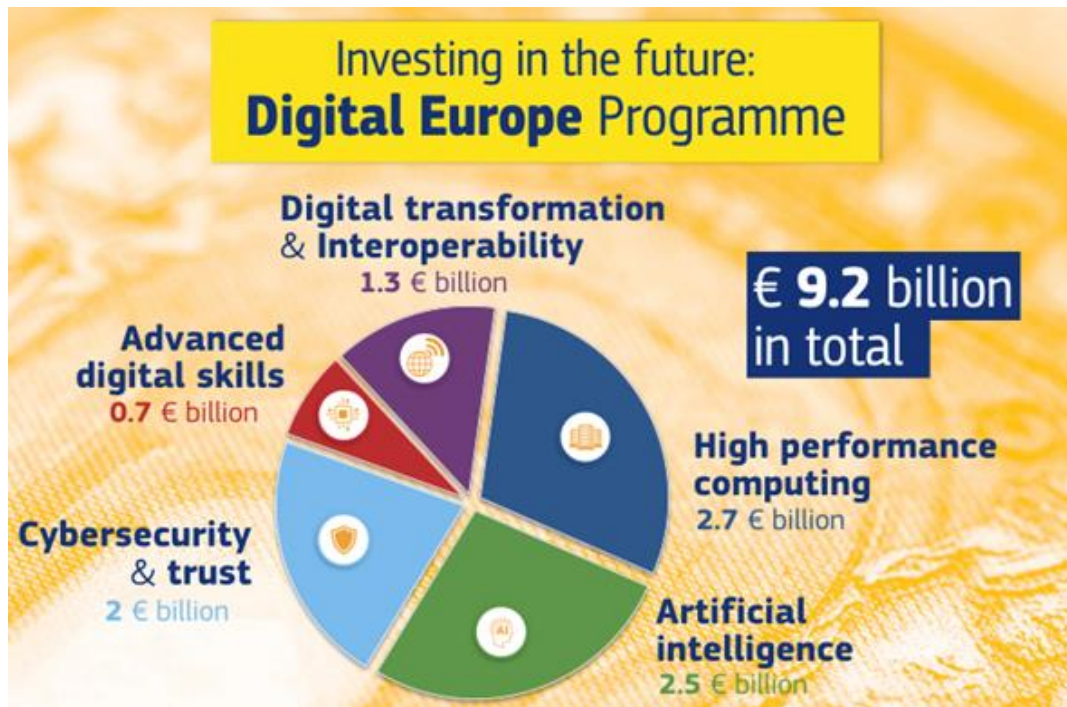

Support and follow latest tech developments

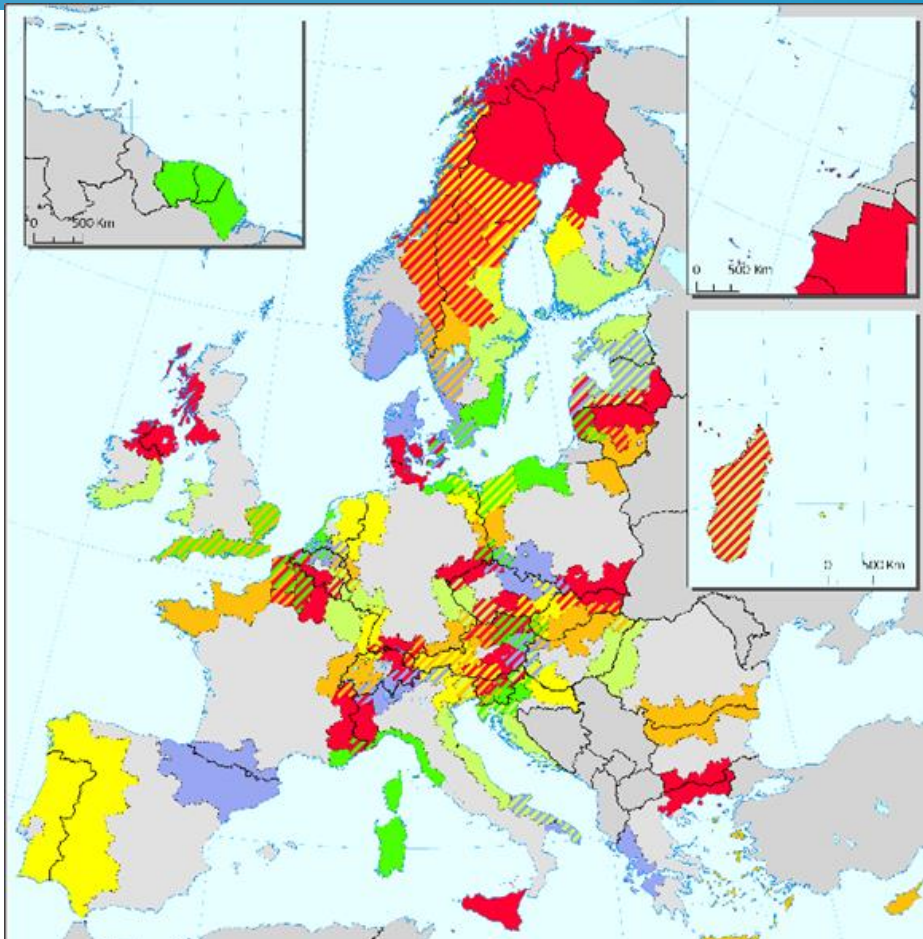


Build up and strengthen the network of Digital Innovation Hubs
