



Pres. Paper "Rethinking European Industry"

- We need a strong presence of technical and practical skills in educational programs/curricula.
- Digitalization is an instrument as well as a future-oriented learning tool but also part of new occupational profiles and professions.
- The Commission's New Skills Agenda is a step in the right direction and contributes to better transparency.
- Lifelong Learning is an instrument to make sure that digitalization reaches out to the citizens, making them aware of chances and risks from early childhood on.

Ministerial Declaration Tallinn 6.10.2017
