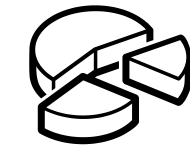

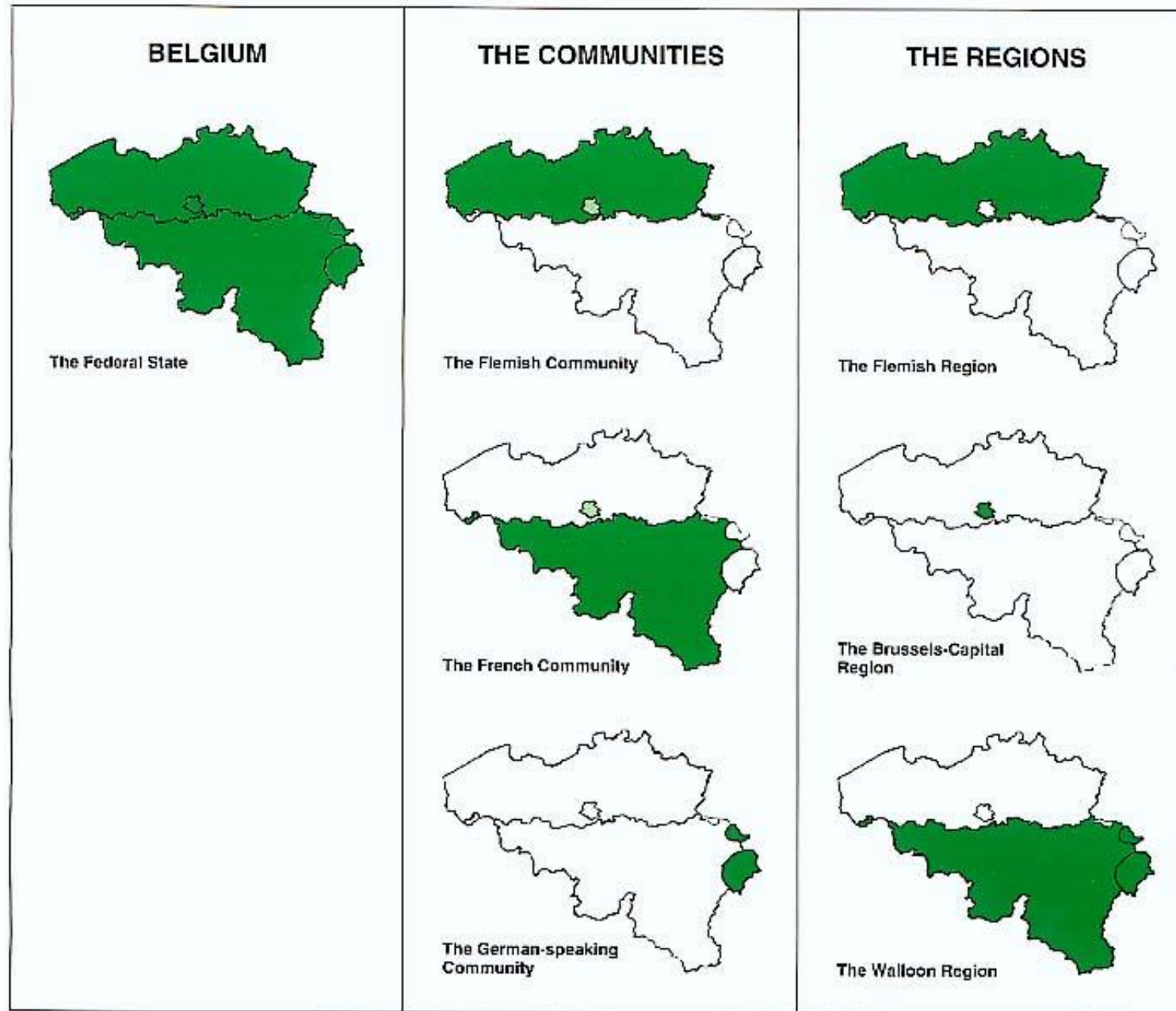
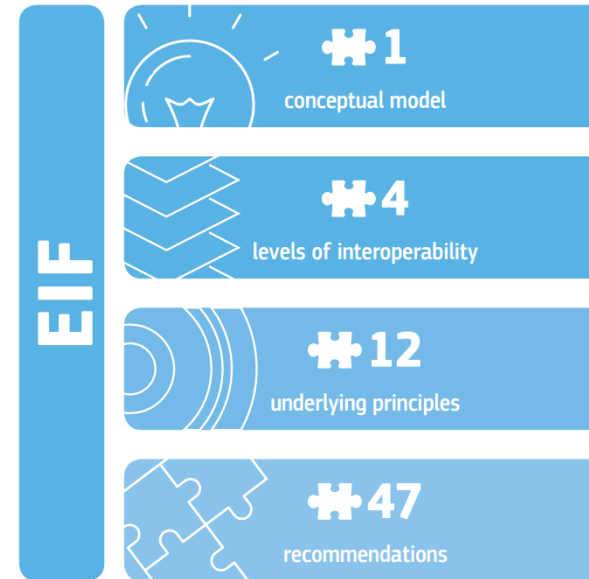
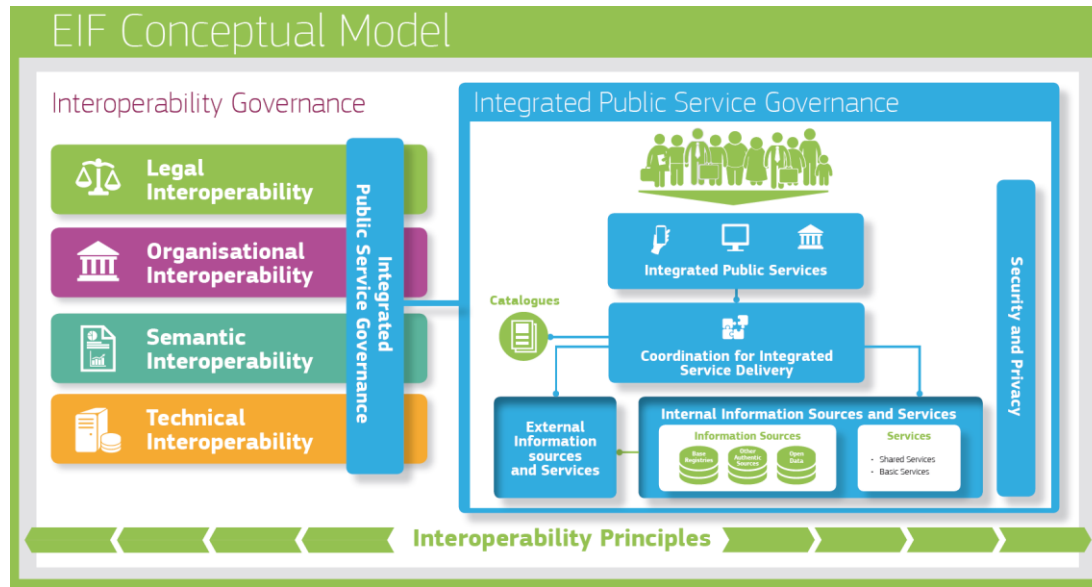






























Fig. 1.1. – Belgium, a Federal State which consists of Communities and Regions.

EIRA, EIF - Overview

The European Interoperability Framework (EIF) is a set of recommendations which specify how administrations, businesses and citizens communicate with each other within the European Union and across Member State borders.

European Interoperability Reference Architecture (EIRA) is a TOGAF based architecture to guide public administrations in their work to provide interoperable European public services to businesses and citizens.

The Reference Architecture consists of 6 layers that all describe what should be considered from an interoperability point of view, when designing and building services.

1. Underlying Principles view

2. Legal view

3. Organisational view

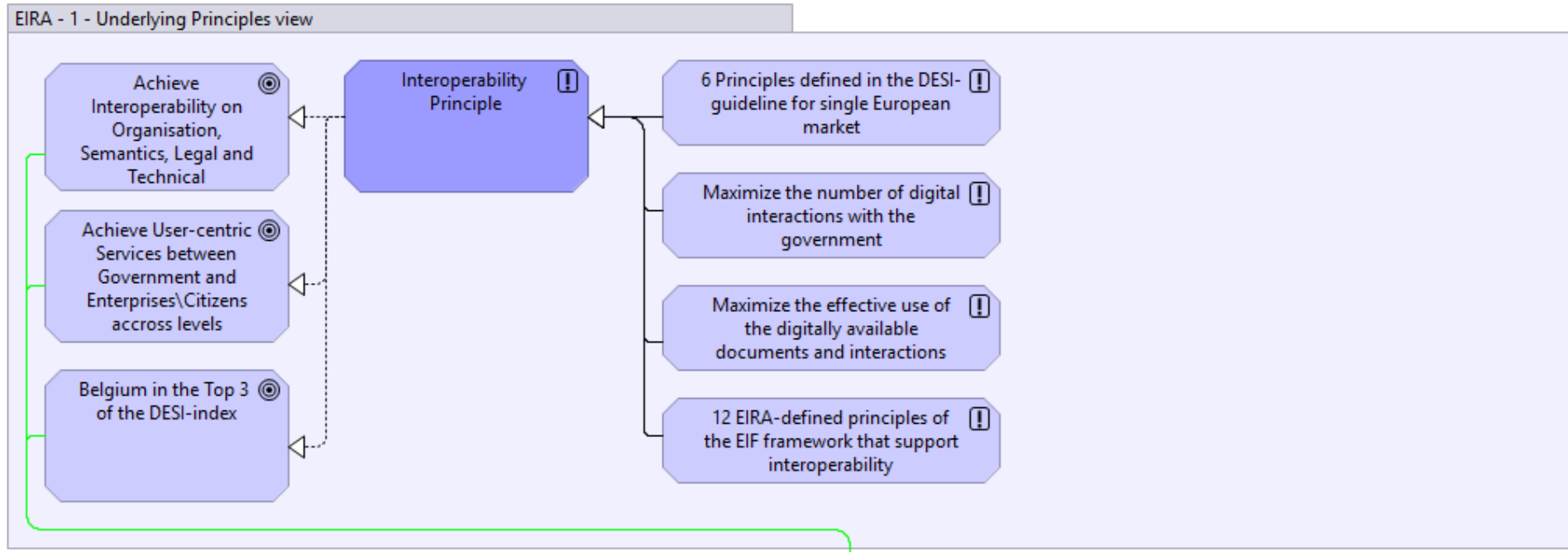

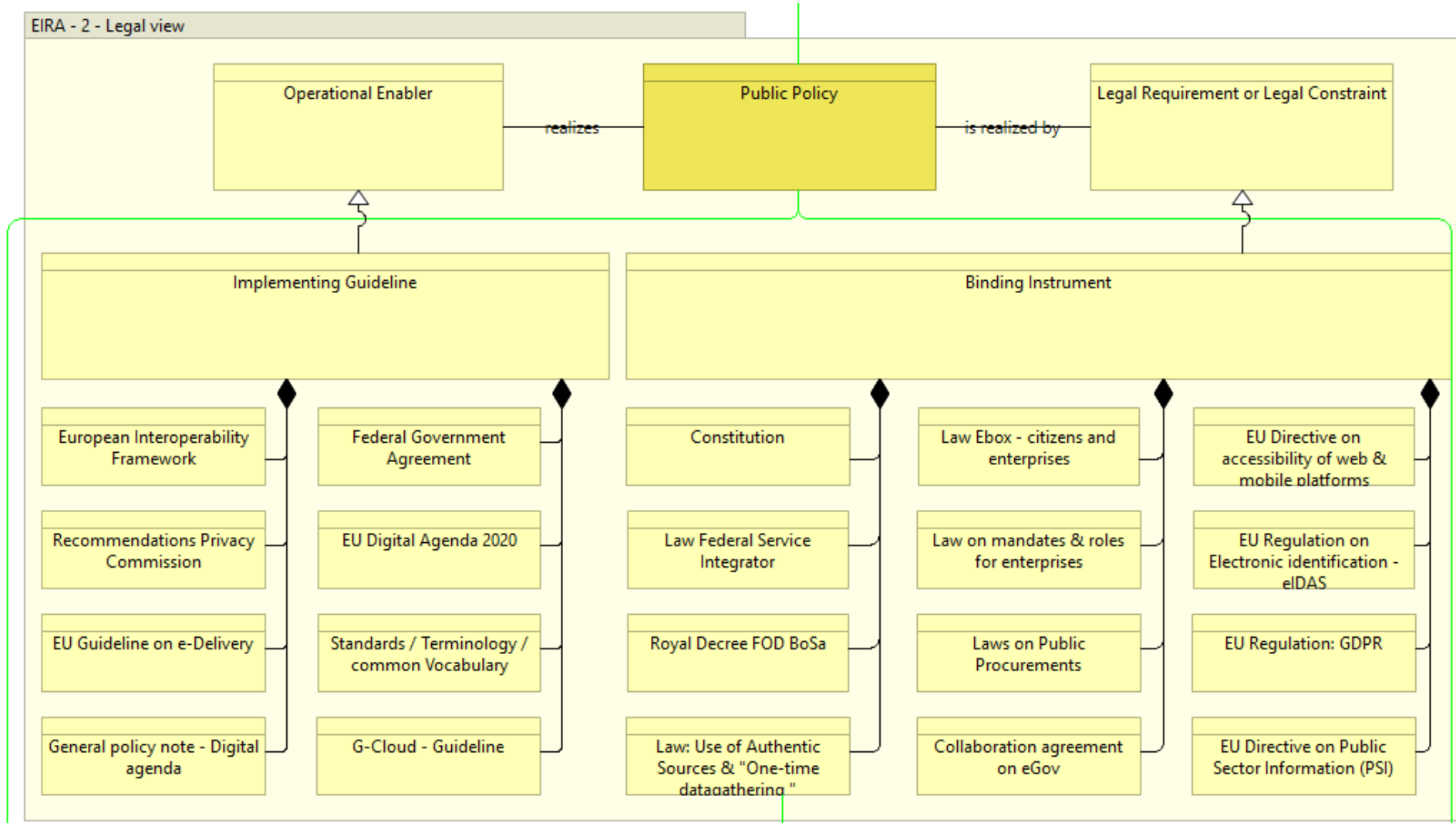

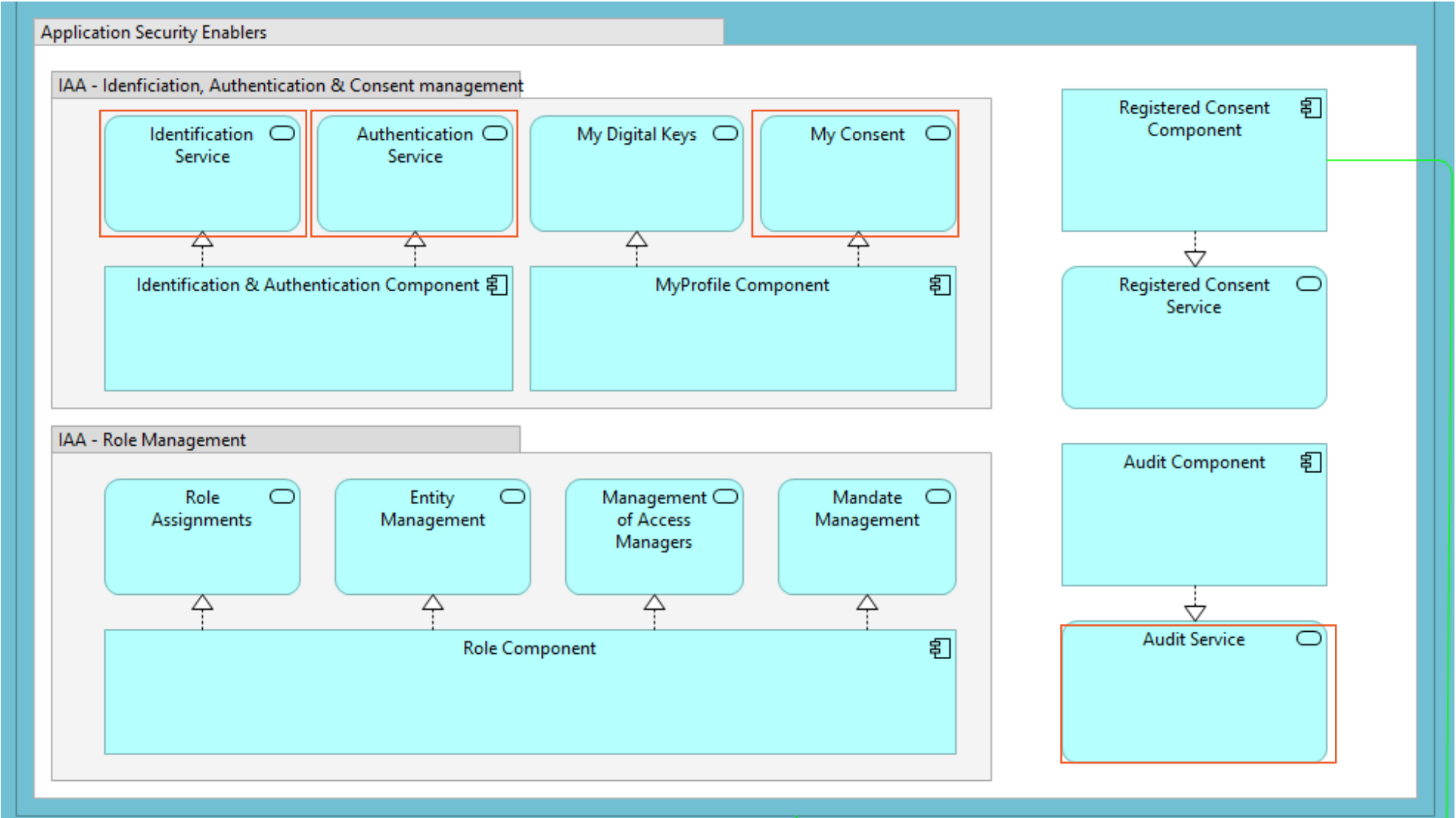
Semantic view (work in progress – Oslo² mapping)

- It is an excellent communication tool
 - To stakeholders, politics, partners
 - To administrations in the other member states
- It is an eye opener
 - Reveals gaps, overlaps,
 - Provides structure for the chaos
 - Comes with a “common language”, for example : list of architectural building blocks (ABB)
- It allows to compare and map different architectures
