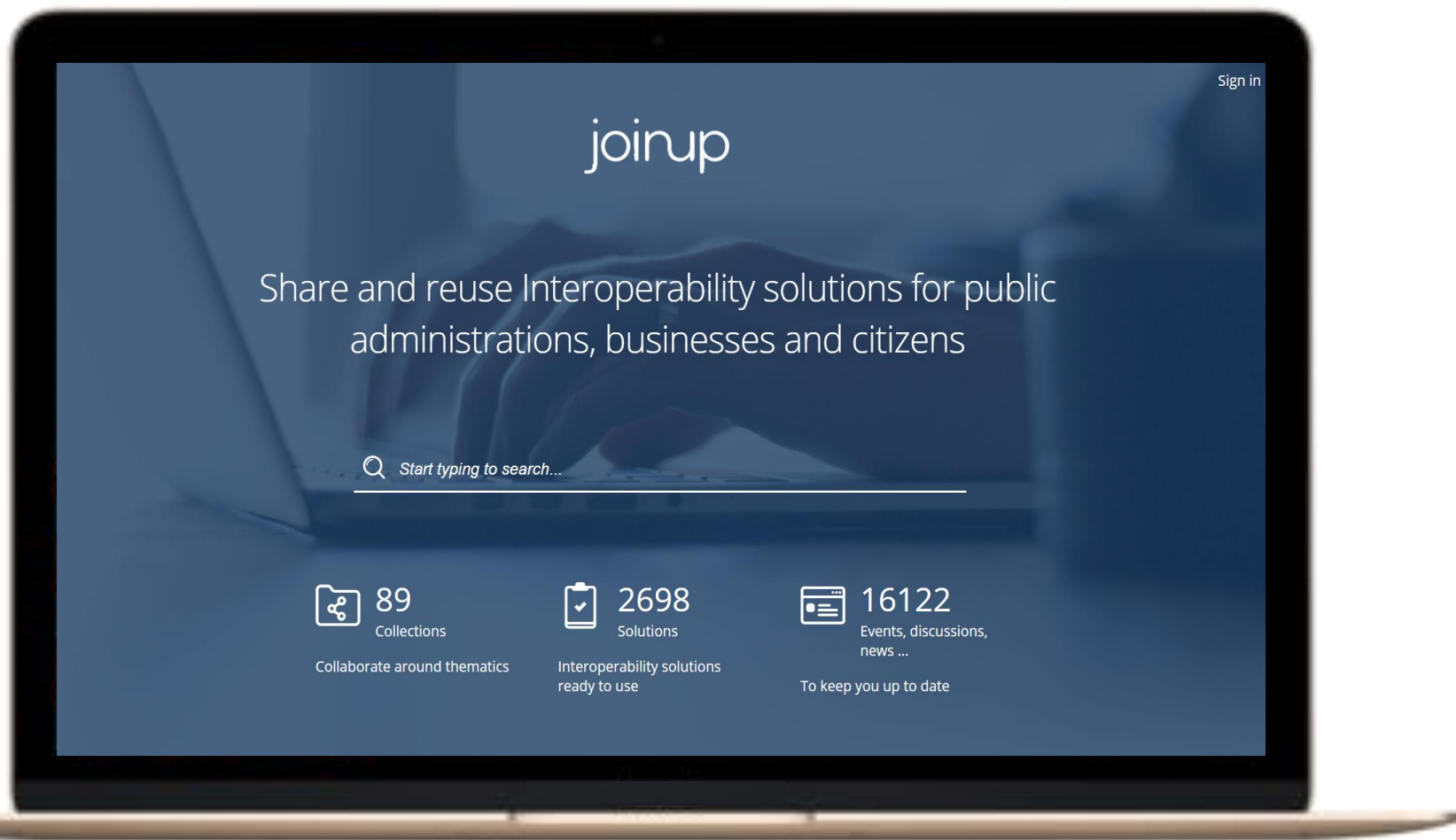

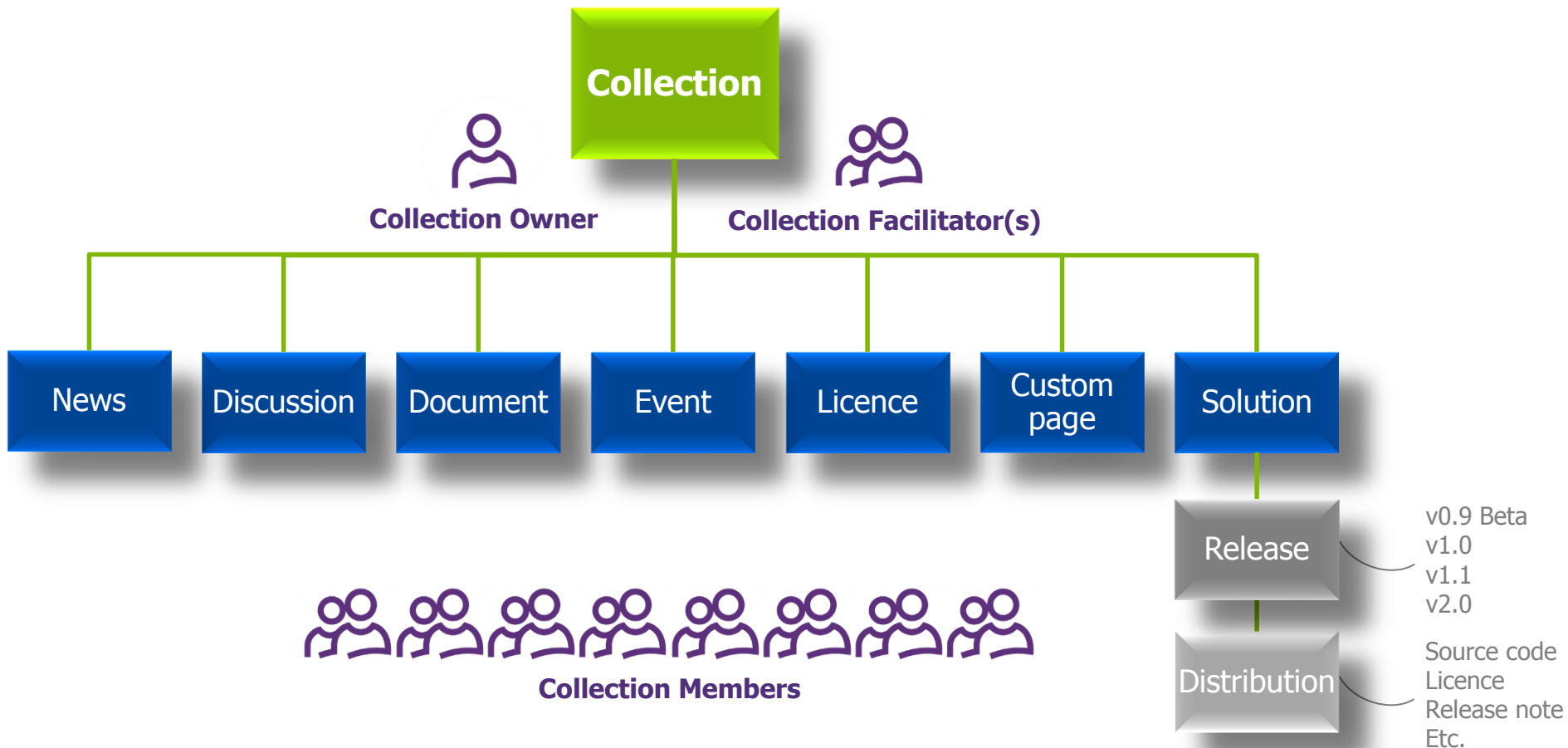
Concepts behind the new Joinup A revamped platform

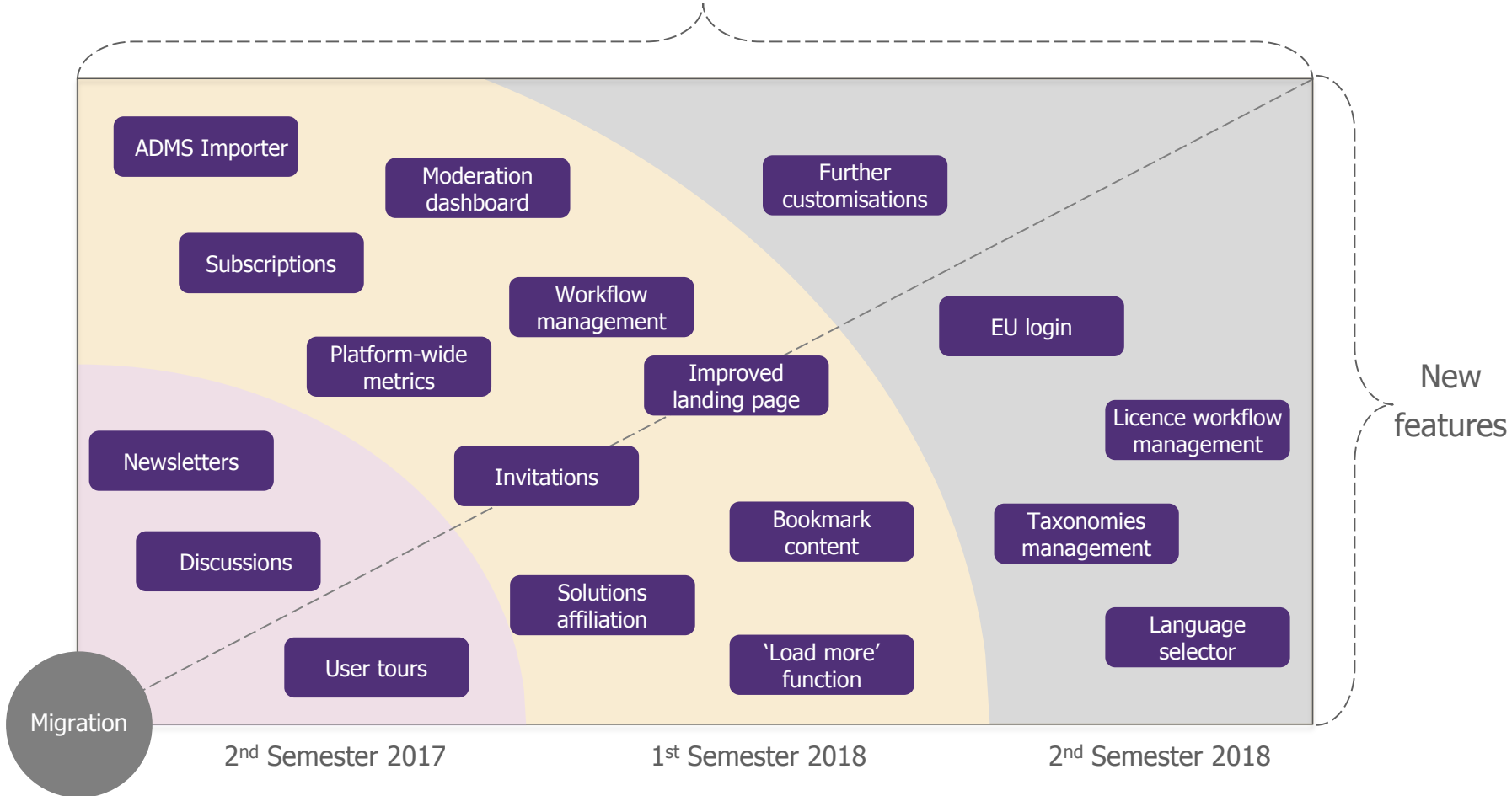
