




eTrustEx is an open-source platform offered to Public Administrations at European, national and regional level to set up secure exchange of any type of data between end-users or system-to-system.



Exchange files in a secure way

Who can use eTrustEx?

eTrustEx can be used by European public administrations that need to exchange electronically any type of data with other entities in any policy domain, in a secure way.

What are the benefits?

- Reusable and customisable cross-sector and open-source platform.
- It uses **standardised** messaging protocols and interfaces (interoperable).
- It ensures a **Secure** and **trusted** exchange of data/documents (integrity, authenticity, confidentiality)
- Users can send files **up to 5 GB** (up to 500 documents of and up to 100MB per file)
- ✓ It is **proven** and **tested**: eTrustEx has been used by the European Commission since 2009.
