

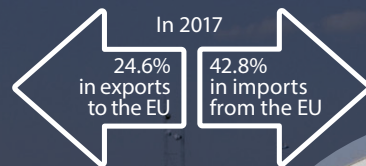

- The EU's contribution to total Foreign Direct Investment was 1.18 billion in 2017
- Volume of trade with the EU was €8.6 billion in 2017

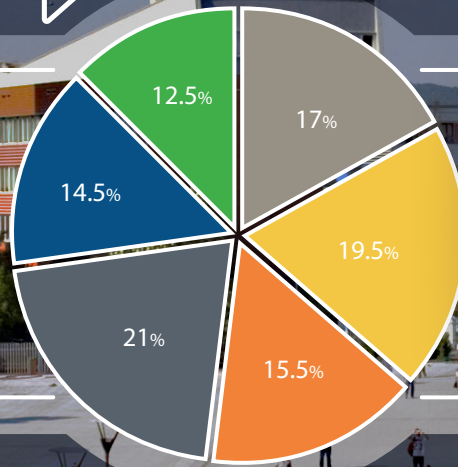


MOBILITY & EMPOWERMENT



- In 2015 – 2016 over 2200 participants in student, academic and youth exchanges under ERASMUS+
- 259 'Young Cells Scheme' grants have been awarded to public administration scholars
- 3500+ young and disadvantaged people received employment and entrepreneurship training

EU FUNDING



The EU is the largest provider of financial assistance to Kosovo

- €1.48 billion in EU assistance funds 2007-2020
- €149 million provided in European Investment Bank loans since 1999
- €95.7 million in Western Balkans Investment Framework grants since 2009, leveraging investments estimated at €764 million

The Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the EU and Kosovo enters into force

MAY 2016

The European Commission proposes visa-free travel for the people of Kosovo

OCTOBER 2016

First meeting of the EU-Kosovo Stabilisation and Association Council
