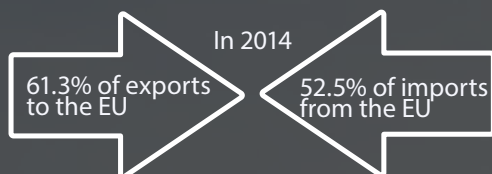

OTHER EU INITIATIVES OR AGREEMENTS

- In 2014 and 2015, Morocco benefitted from the incentive-based mechanism and was awarded additional funding of respectively €20 million and €30 million.
- Since 2010, Morocco has been a beneficiary of the Neighbourhood Investment Facility (NIF). To date, 10 projects with a total amount of €203.8 million have been co-funded, including the NOOR / Ouarzazate largest solar power station in Africa (expected to power more than a million homes).
- In addition to the European Neighbourhood Instrument bilateral support, Morocco also receives funding from EU thematic and regional programmes and instruments, such as the European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights (EIDHR), the Non-state Actors and Local Authorities (NSA/LA) programme or the Civil society facility - totalling €14.1 million since 2011.
