### ENRD Rural Bioeconomy Portal

The ENRD Contact Point launched on 6 November 2018 a new online [Rural Bioeconomy Portal](#) collecting resources such as relevant documents, links to tools, projects and organisations related to bioeconomy.

The portal is part of the ENRD thematic work on '[Mainstreaming the Bioeconomy](#)' and focuses on the challenges and opportunities from developing the bioeconomy in European rural areas. It is freely accessible and allows users to suggest further content. The portal will soon be available in French, German, Italian, Polish and Spanish.



### EU Bioeconomy Strategy: an update

The European Commission [published](#) in October 2018 its [updated bioeconomy strategy](#) and action plan to develop a sustainable and circular bioeconomy across the EU.

The new document is a revision of the [2012 bioeconomy strategy](#) and aims to improve and scale up the sustainable use of renewable resources to address global and local challenges such as climate change and sustainable development.
