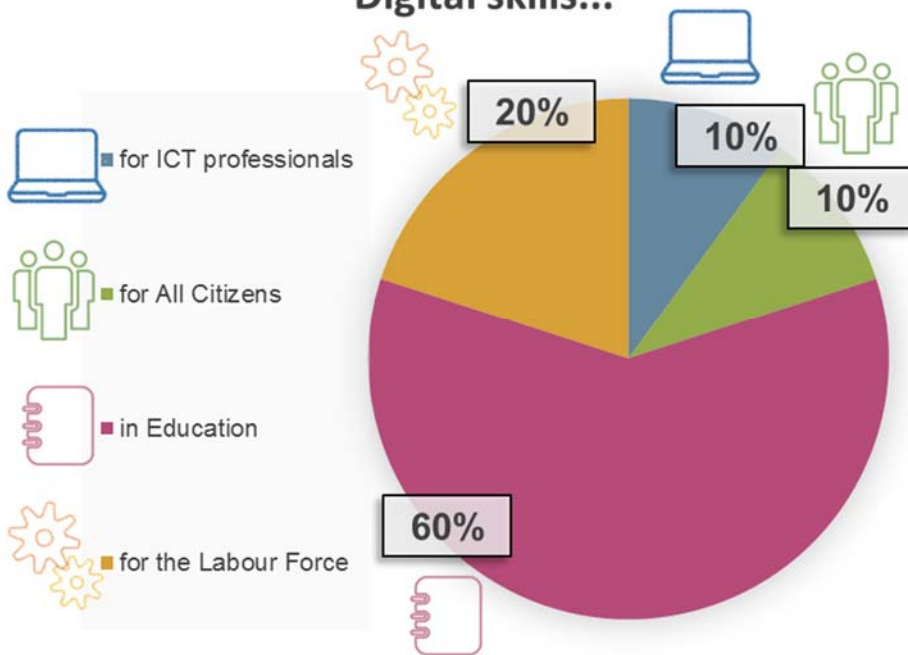

- CoderDojo – CoderDojo is a growing community of free coding clubs for children which is supported by volunteer IT specialists. In Bulgaria 2200 children take part in these clubs.
- Coding4all – Coding4All projects ensure that there is a growing network of teachers working with children in the field of STEAM. In Bulgaria 100 teachers and 2000 kids are participating.
- eStart@School - A platform that brings together 1000 experienced teachers, providing advice and support for their peers.
- Rails Girls – Rails Girls provides free introductory coding workshops for women, with the aim to get them into tech jobs.
