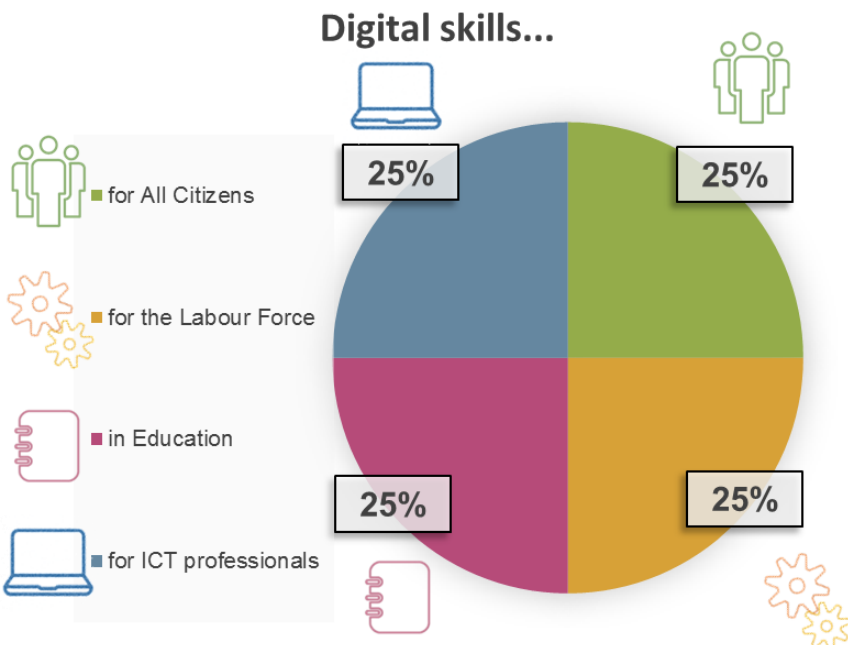

It involves a broad range of stakeholders with the aim to have a digitally advanced Portugal by 2030. INCoDe.2030 expects that by 2030, every Portuguese household will have internet access, and the number of frequent internet users will grow to 90%.

Main achievements and projects

- The 1st Conference of the Permanent Forum for Digital Competencies brought together over 1000 stakeholders in digital skills and jobs. The purpose of the forum was to ensure a broad mobilization for the National Digital Competence Initiative e.2030 | Portugal INCoDe.2030
- The Portuguese Council of Ministers enacted a Diploma which approves the National Initiative for Digital Competences e.2030 – Portugal INCoDe.2030 as a Programme. This Diploma (RCM 26/2018, 8 March) formalizes and reinforces INCoDe.2030's structure and objectives.
- Dynamic Digital Competence Reference Framework (QDRCD) - In order to integrate a set of digital competences acquired through different subsystems of education and training, improving the transparency of benchmarks for the comparison of digital skills a Digital Competence Reference Framework (built upon DigComp 2.1).
