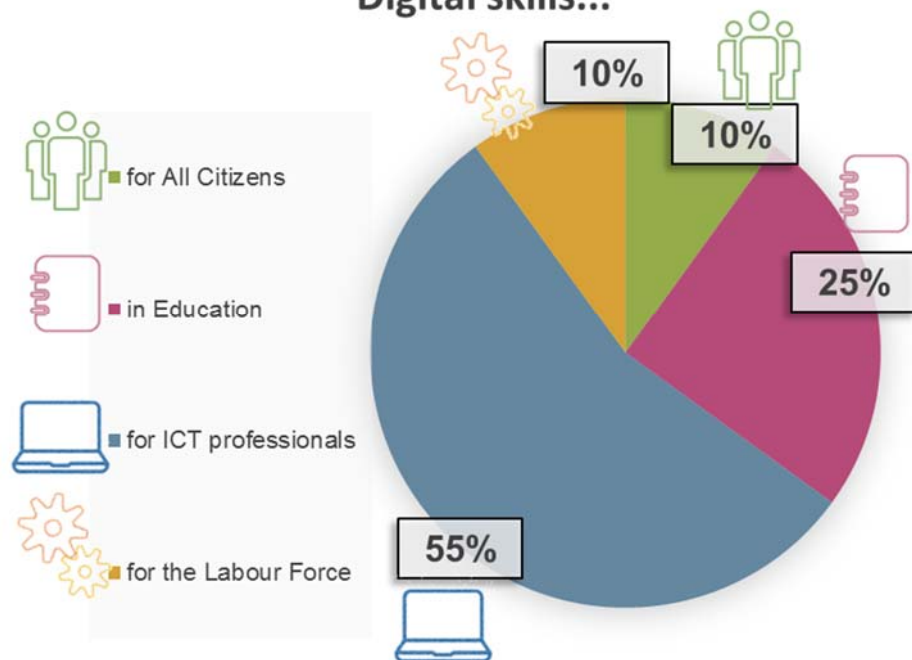

### Main achievements and projects

- The Croatian e-Schools project aims to ensure that digitally competent teachers have use of adequate ICT equipment and that they develop e-content for digital education, meeting the needs of the labour market. Currently there are 150 schools included in the pilot project running until 2018, 29 of which are vocational schools and 21 gymnasiums. The schools are being equipped with at least one ICT classroom and receive equipment including laptops, tablets, presentation equipment, and wired and wireless local area networks.
- Initiative to raise the skills of unemployed people by training and offering the ECDL certificates to 2500 unemployed Croatians.
